## About Sliding Billboard

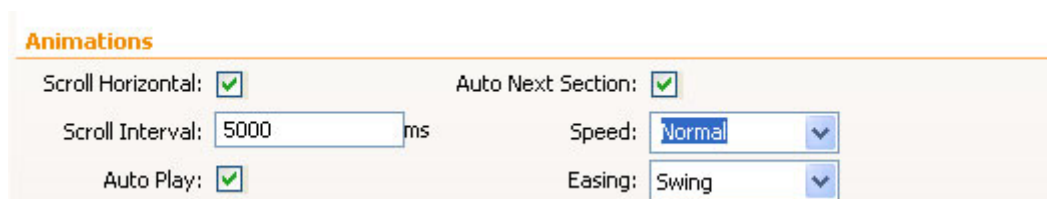

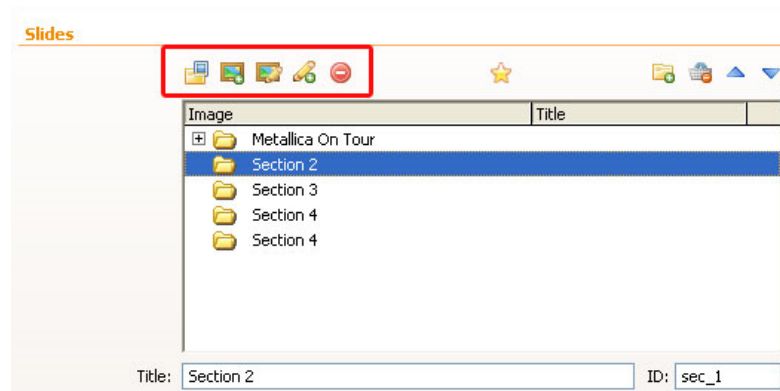
- **Pure CSS Gallery** - Doesn't require any plugins and works on all modern browsers

  - **Animation easing and speed** - regular sliding is not enough for you? How about bouncing or elastic sliding?



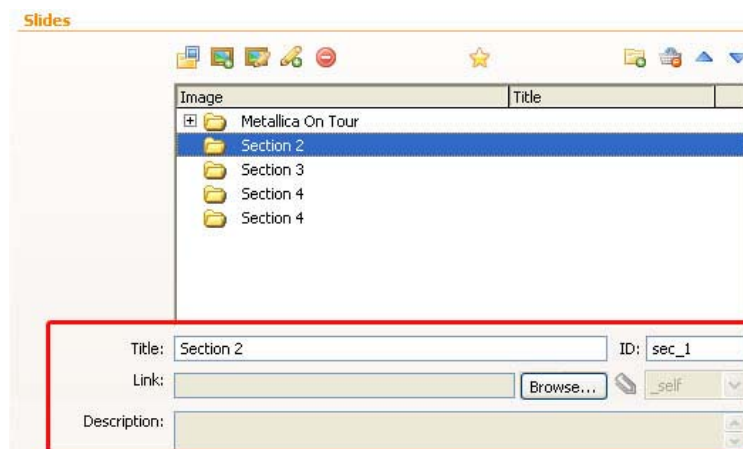
- **Auto Paginating** - Quick access to all the pages in the Sliding Billboard

- **DMXzone Resizer included** - Integrated Resizer, so that you don't need to use any additional programs to fit the images to the Billboard

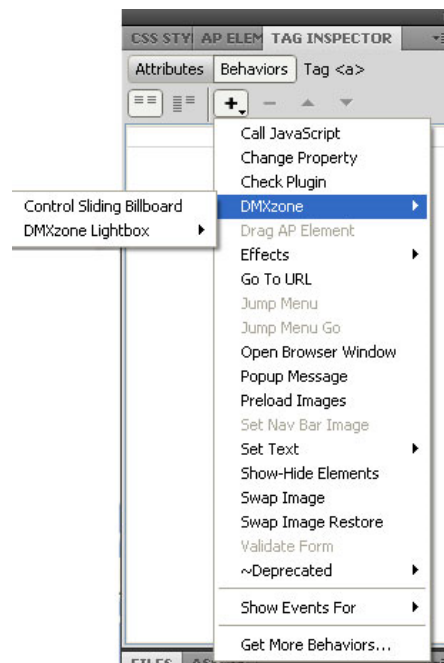

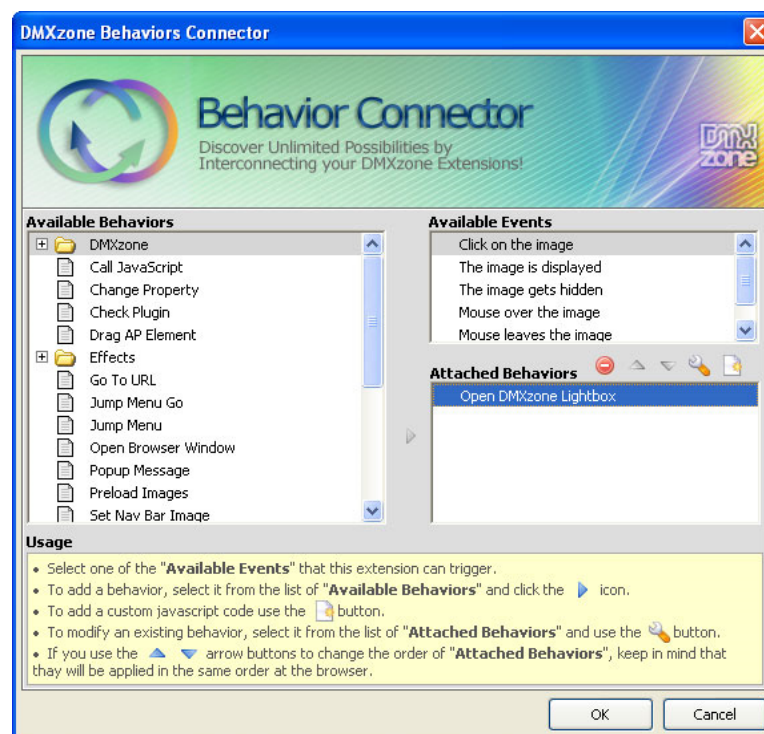
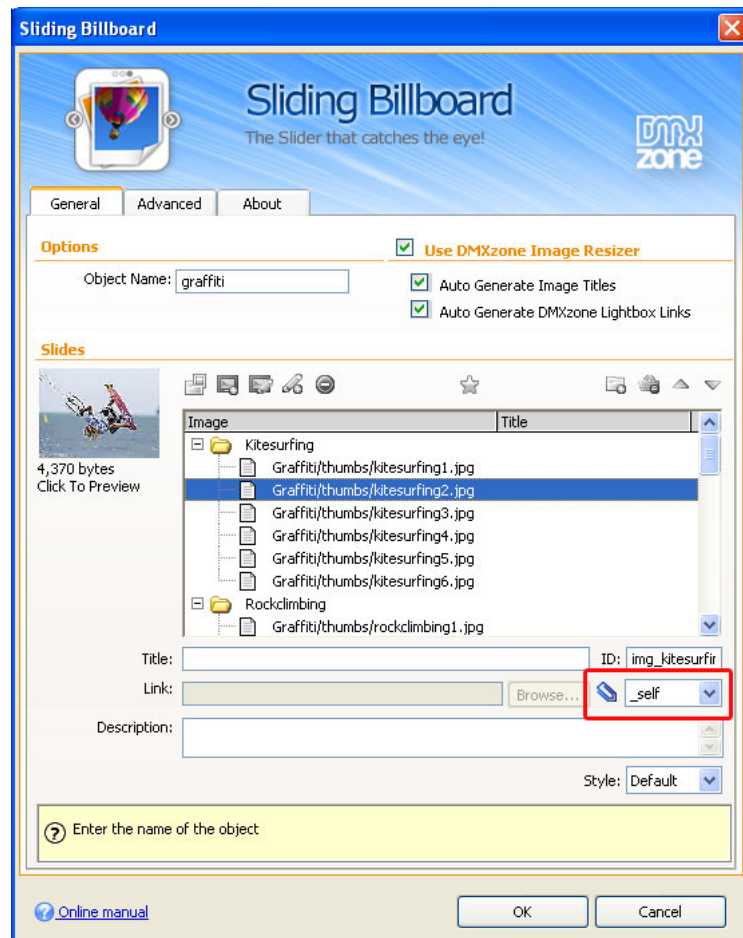

- Fully Controllable by behaviors** - You want to navigate to specific position, start or stop the billboard - it can be easily done with the Control Sliding Billboard behavior.

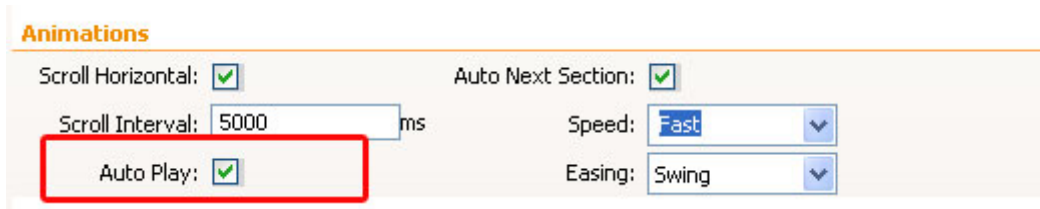

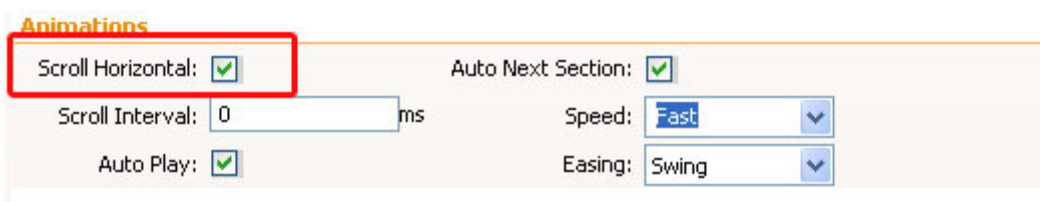
- **Don't want auto sliding** – Well, just do NOT set Auto Play - and then the user will navigate manually only



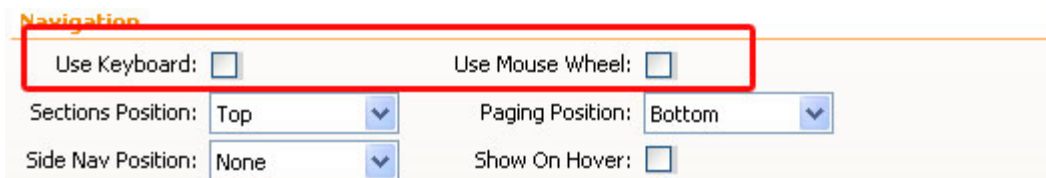
- **Auto anchor navigation** - You want to have your own link somewhere else on your page and when the user click on it, the billboard should go to a specific section? Easy just use as link #section\_name



- **Horizontal or Vertical scroll** - The choice is yours



- **Full support for keyboard and mouse wheel navigation (optional)**



- **Customizable Navigation Position** - You can choose where you want your section and page navigation top or bottom

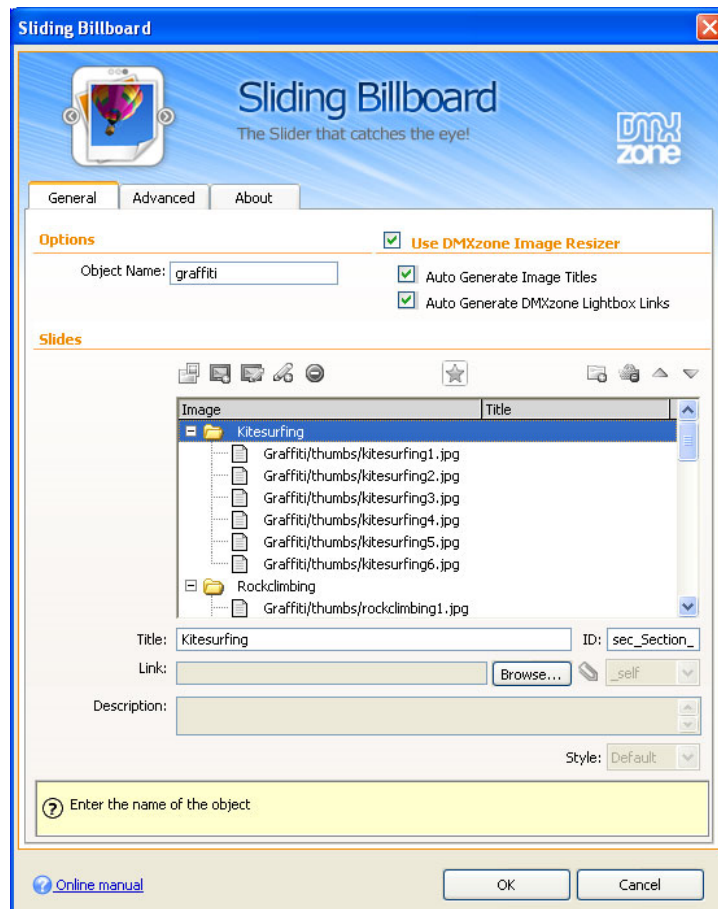

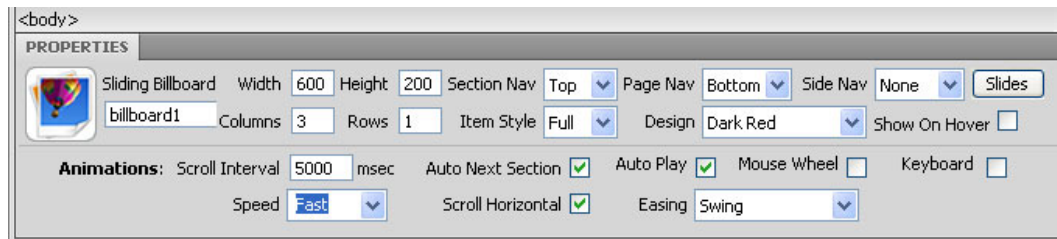

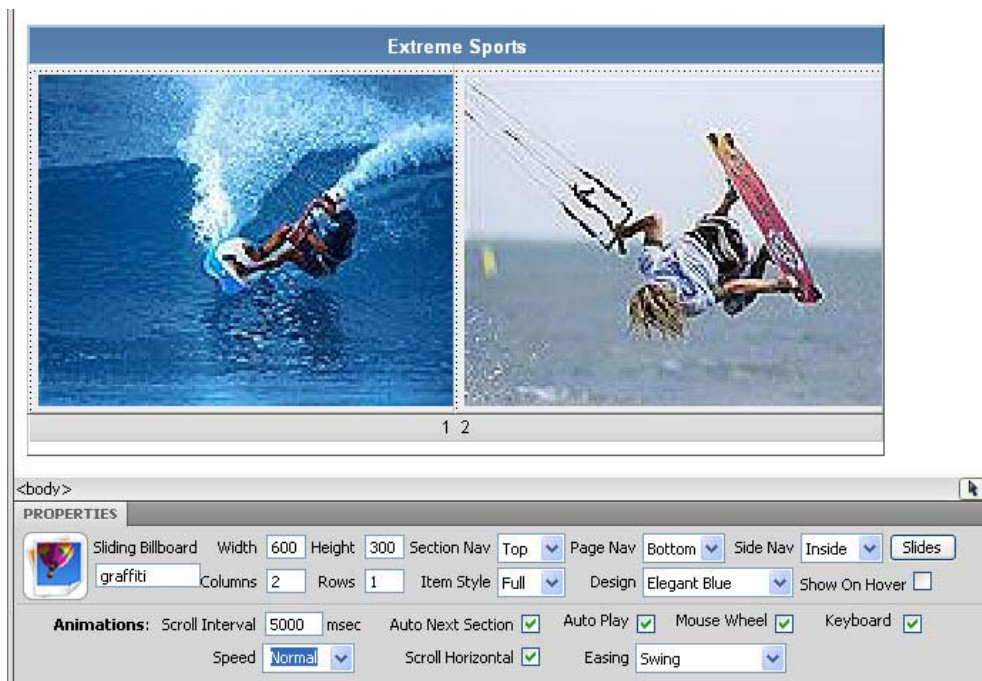

## The Basics: Creating a simple Sliding Billboard

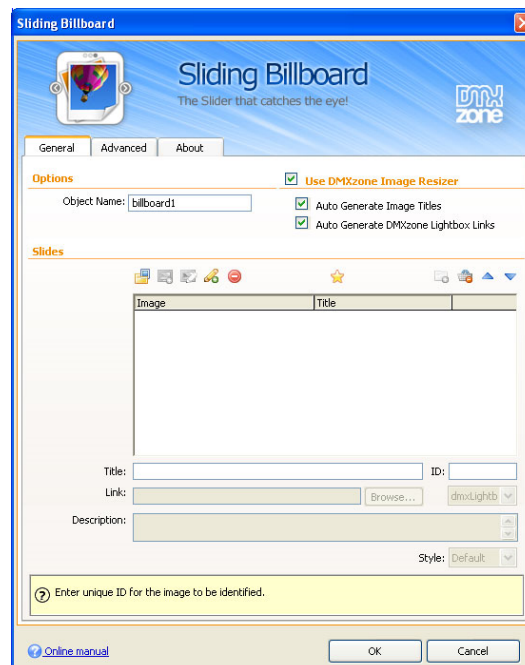


### How to do it

1. Define your site in Dreamweaver and create a new page.
2. **Applying the extension** – Choose the  icon from the DMXzone object bar to apply the extension.

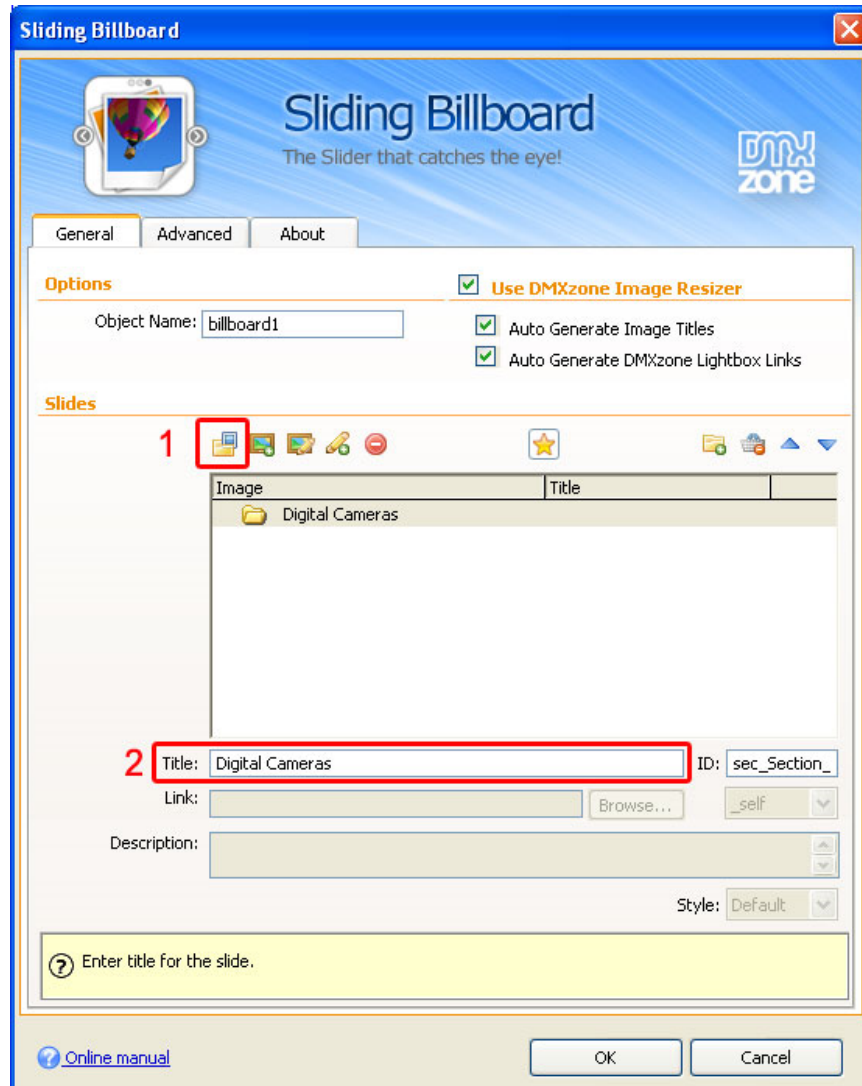


The Sliding Billboard dialog appears:



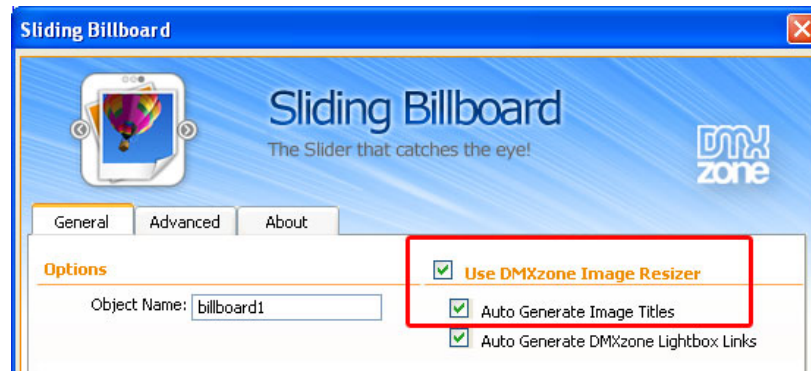
### 3. Creating Billboard Sections

Click the **Add new section** button and set a new section and add a custom title.

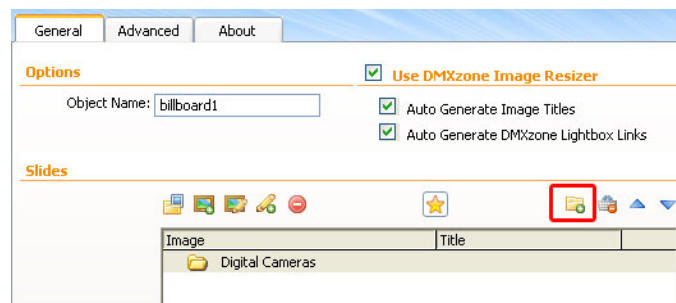


#### 4. Importing a folder of content

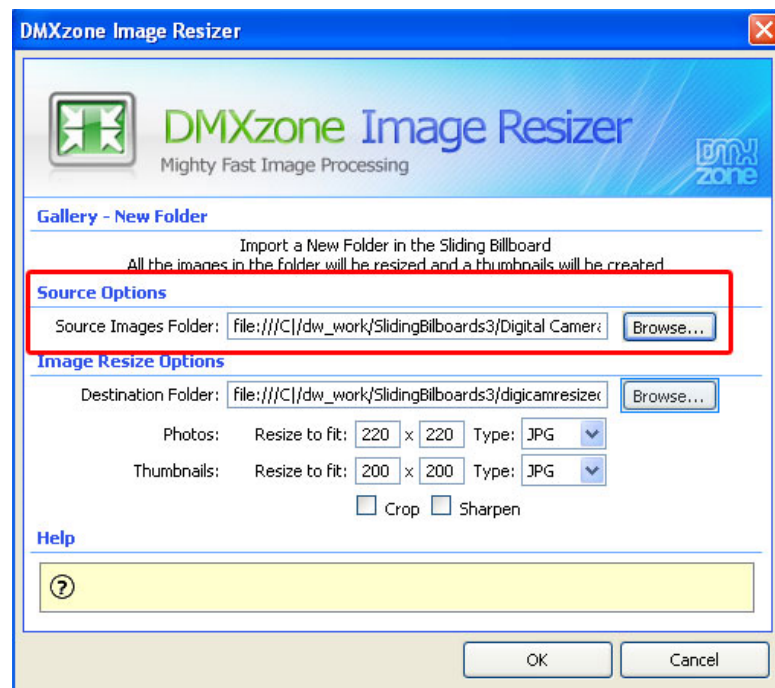
There is an option where you can use **the DMXzone Image Resizer** and **Auto Generate Image Titles** for the image slides.



In our case we will import a whole folder of content to our Sliding Billboard. Click to **Import a whole folder** of images and the DMXzone Image Resizer window will open.

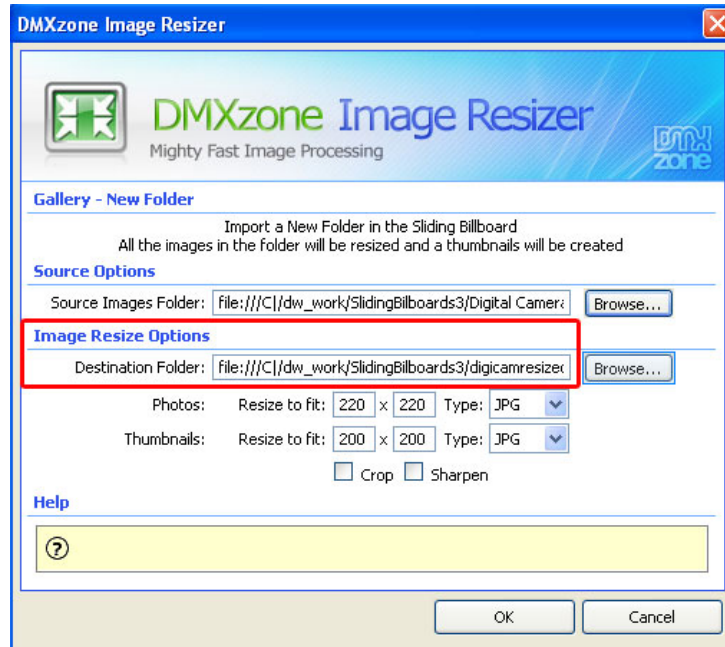


Now, it is time to set the **Source Images Folder**. This is the location of the images you want to use in your album.

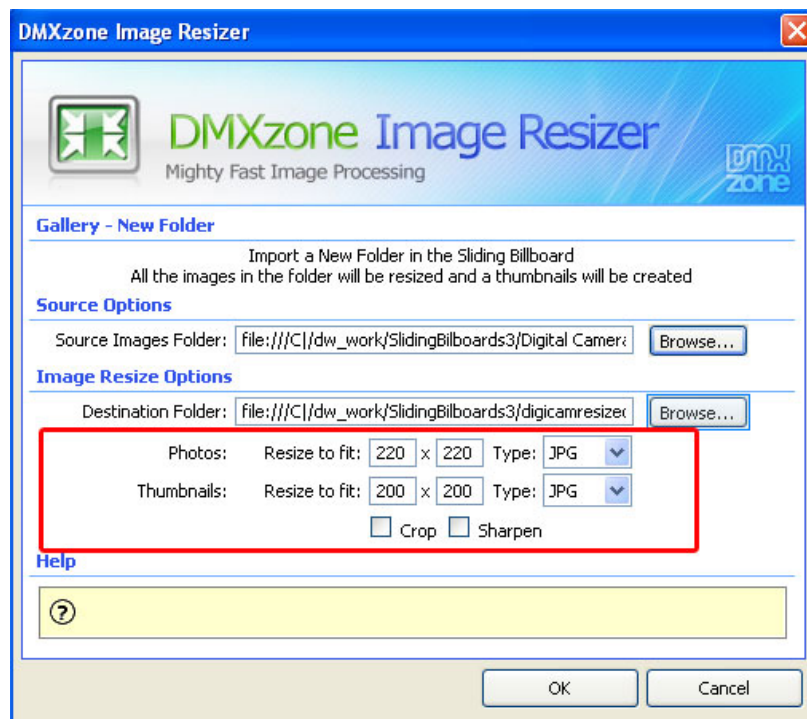




We will select the **Destination Folder** to determine where the resized images and thumbnails of your billboard will be saved.



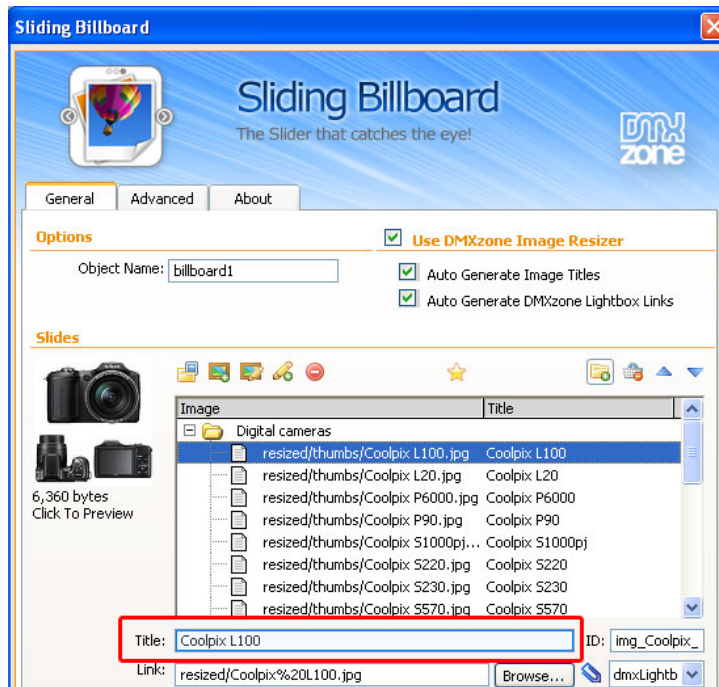
Finally, select the format you want your photos to be in. You have a choice from JPG, PNG, and GIF. You can set the sizes of your images manually or leave them at their default values. Choose if you want to **Crop** your thumbnails. If you enable this, the image size will be as specified but the image will not be whole. You have the option to **Sharpen** your images as well.





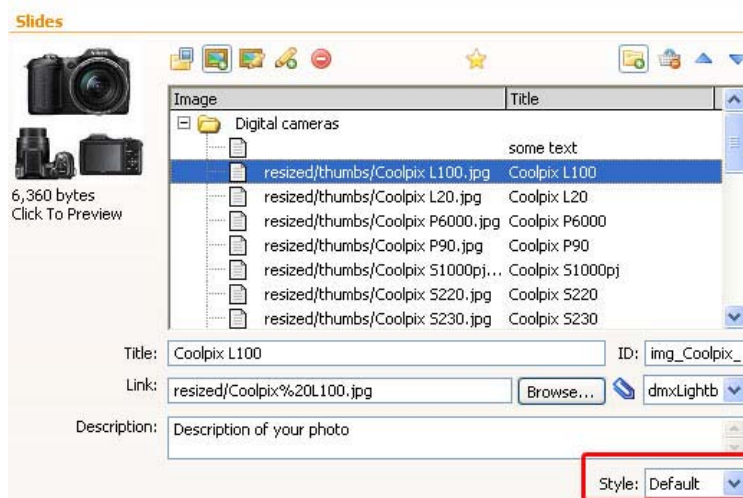
The result so far should look like this:

As you can see the **Title** of the slide is auto generated from the image name and below the link to your resized image.



### 5. Selecting a Billboard Layout.

You can set a different layout for each slide and/or use a global layout for all. In this tutorial we used the **default** one.



Now, we are going to set the Billboard **Title**, **Width**, **Height** and number of **Row** and **Columns** that we need, as well as one of the many CSS Design Styles. For our Billboard we have selected the **Apple Inspired Dark**.

In the **Navigation** section we choose to use the keyboard and mouse wheel (to control the Billboard) and select the positions of **Sections**, **Paging** and **Side Navigation**. Also, we've decided for the following **Animation** settings.

## 6. Generating the Sliding Billboard

Press **OK** to generate your Sliding Billboard. Don't forget to copy the images folder and the styles folder to your server. Press **F12** in order to preview your work and **Save** the project.

## Advanced: Slides Layout

In this tutorial we will go through the options in the Advanced Sliding Billboard Tab.

### Options

#### 1. Main Layout

The Main Layout contains: **Title**, **Width**, **Height** (1), **Columns**, **Rows** (2) and the **Design** of the Billboard (3). The title is the one that will appear on your Billboard design; you can also set the Height and Width of the Billboard, so that it fits your site design. Choose one of the great CSS3 designs and impress your users.

#### 2. Navigation and Animation

In the **Navigation** section you have the choice to navigate your billboard with keyboard and mouse wheel, and to decide the Positioning of the sections/side navigation and paging. You can also choose if you want to have side navigation arrow buttons, where should they be positioned inside, outside, middle and when; always or only on mouse over (hover).

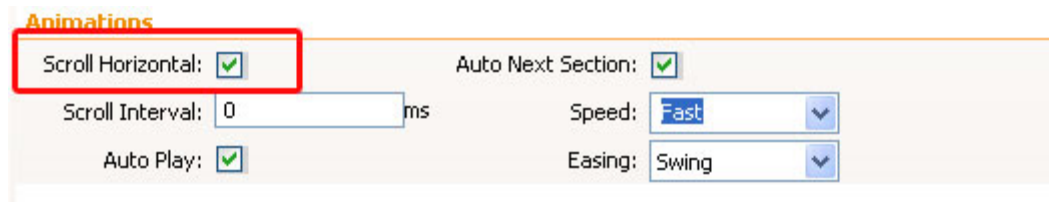

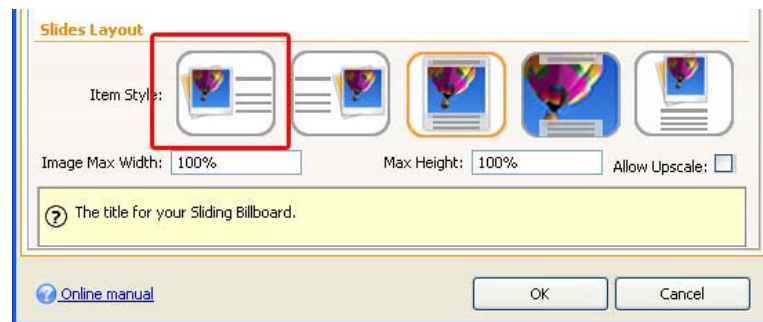
Note: If you don't want your Billboard to slide automatically just uncheck the Auto Play and then the user will navigate manually only.

The **Animations** Section provides options to help you navigate through the sections. If you have the Scroll horizontal checked that means that your Billboard's section will scroll horizontal and your pages Vertical and vice versa if it's not checked.

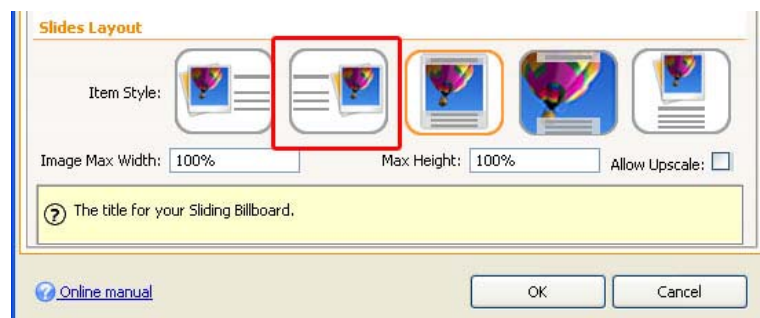


### 3. Slides Layout

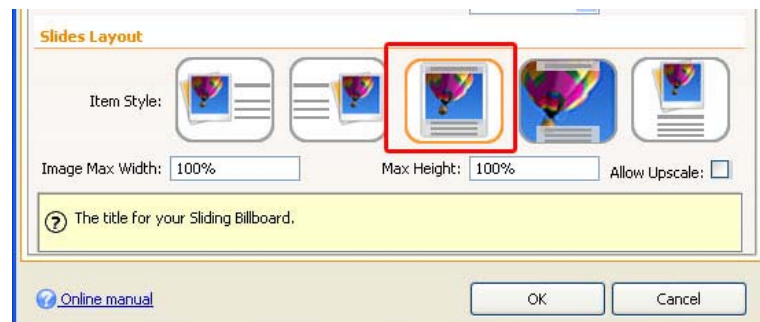
In the first Style the image appears on the left and the title with the description on the right.



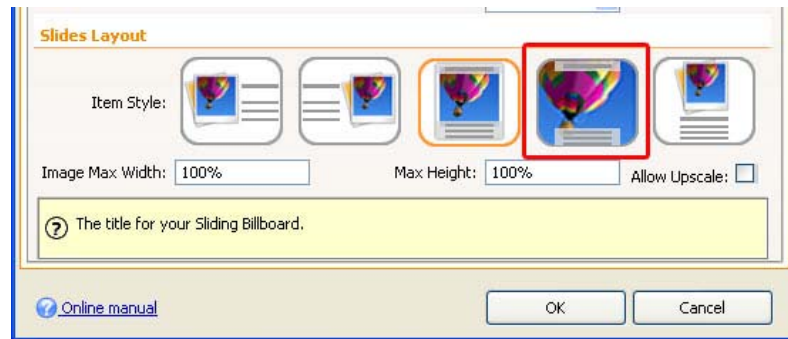
The second style aligns your content (title and description) on the right with an image positioned on the left.



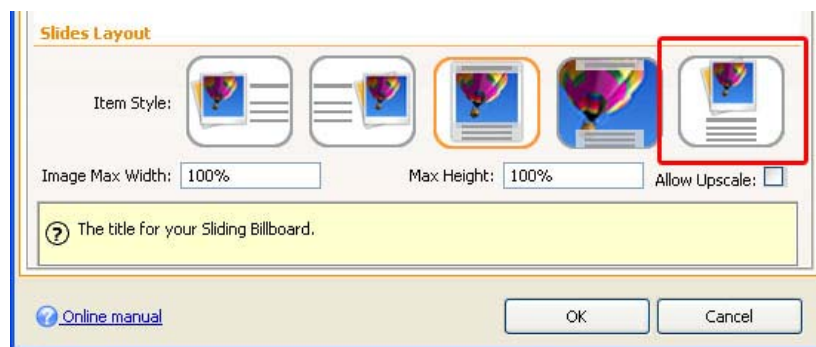
The third design centers the image and the description appears on the bottom.



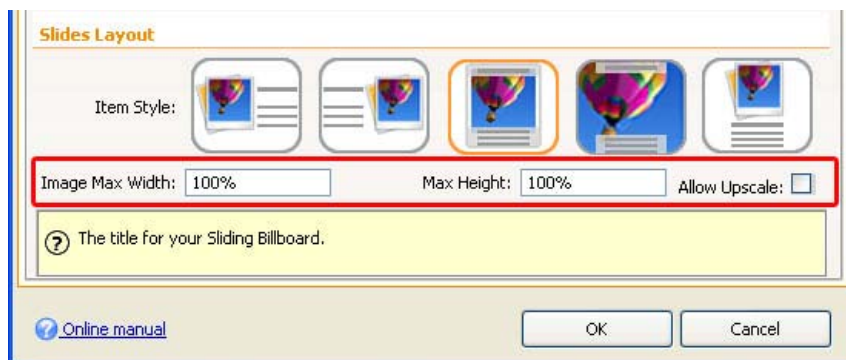
The next layout stretches the image to fit the slide fully with title and description sliding on top of it.



The last alignment positions the image on top and title with description on the bottom.



The additional options Image Max Width and Max Height allow you to specify how much space the image will take from the slide. For example 50% width and item style left, will make the image occupy 50% of the slide and will leave 50% for title and description.
