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How to do it

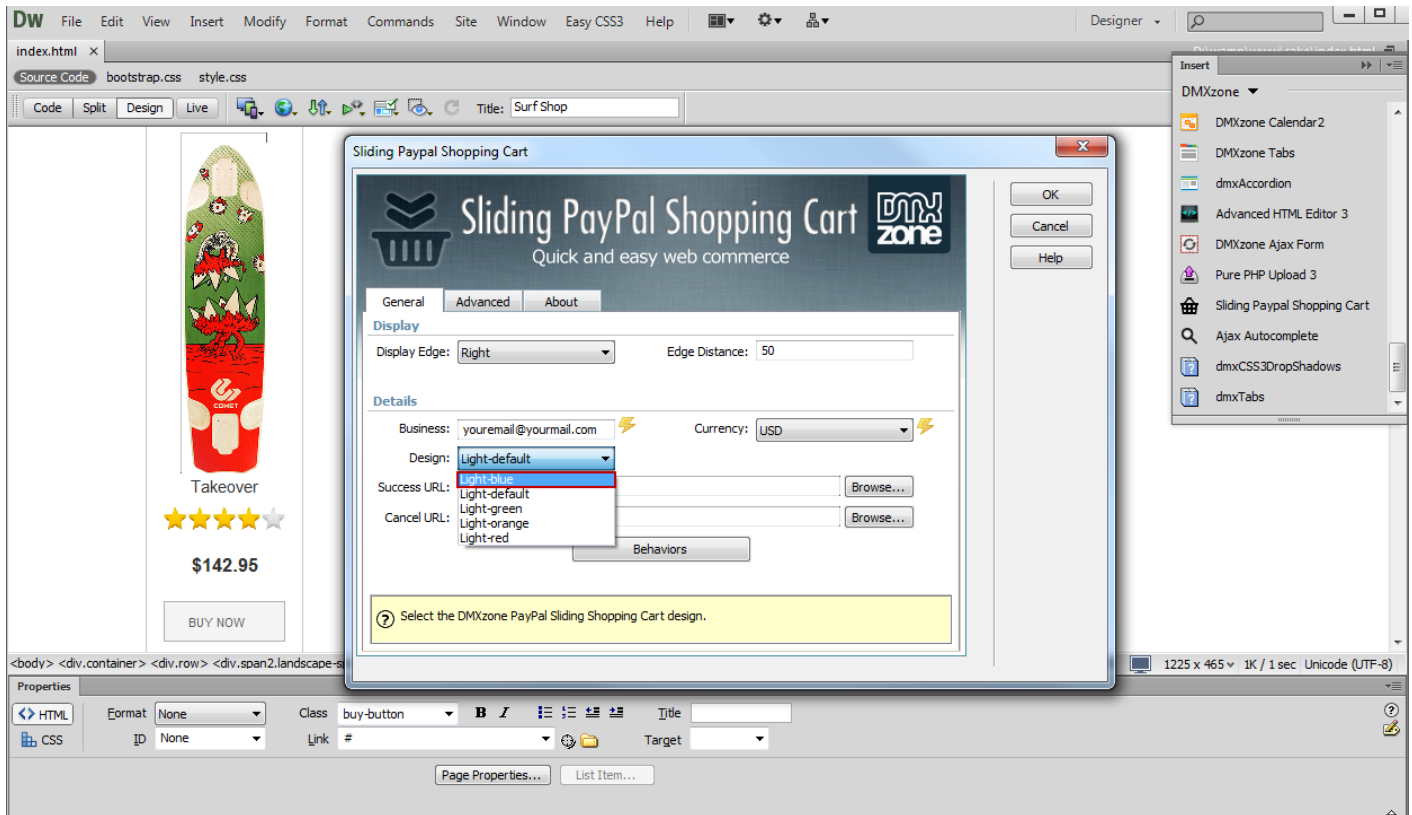
2. In the Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart window, **select the edge** of the page where the cart should be pinned to **(1)** and **set the distance from the edge (2)**. The default value is 50 pixels, you can also use percent. Add your PayPal ID or the email address associated with your PayPal account **(3)** and select a **currency** for the payment **(4)**.

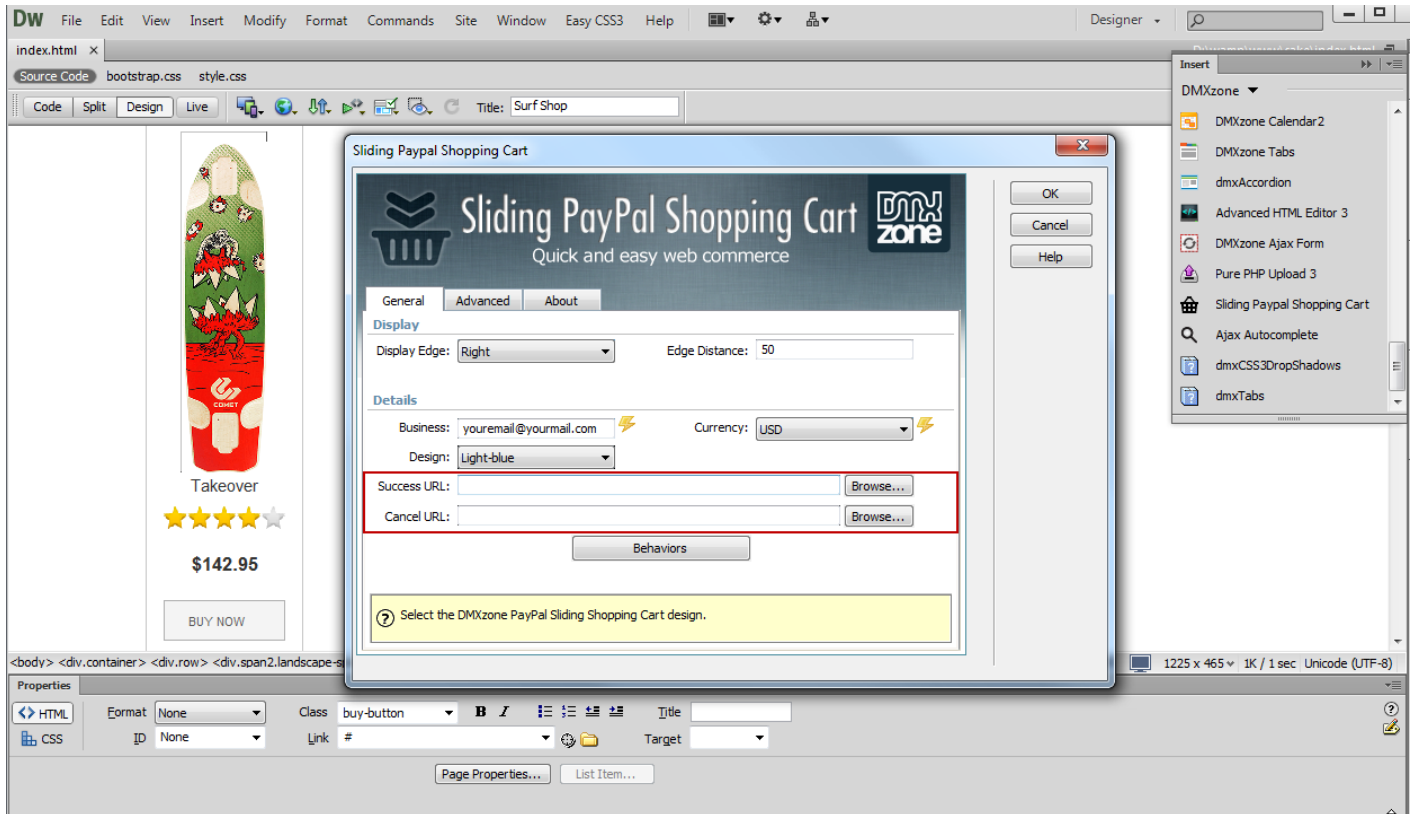

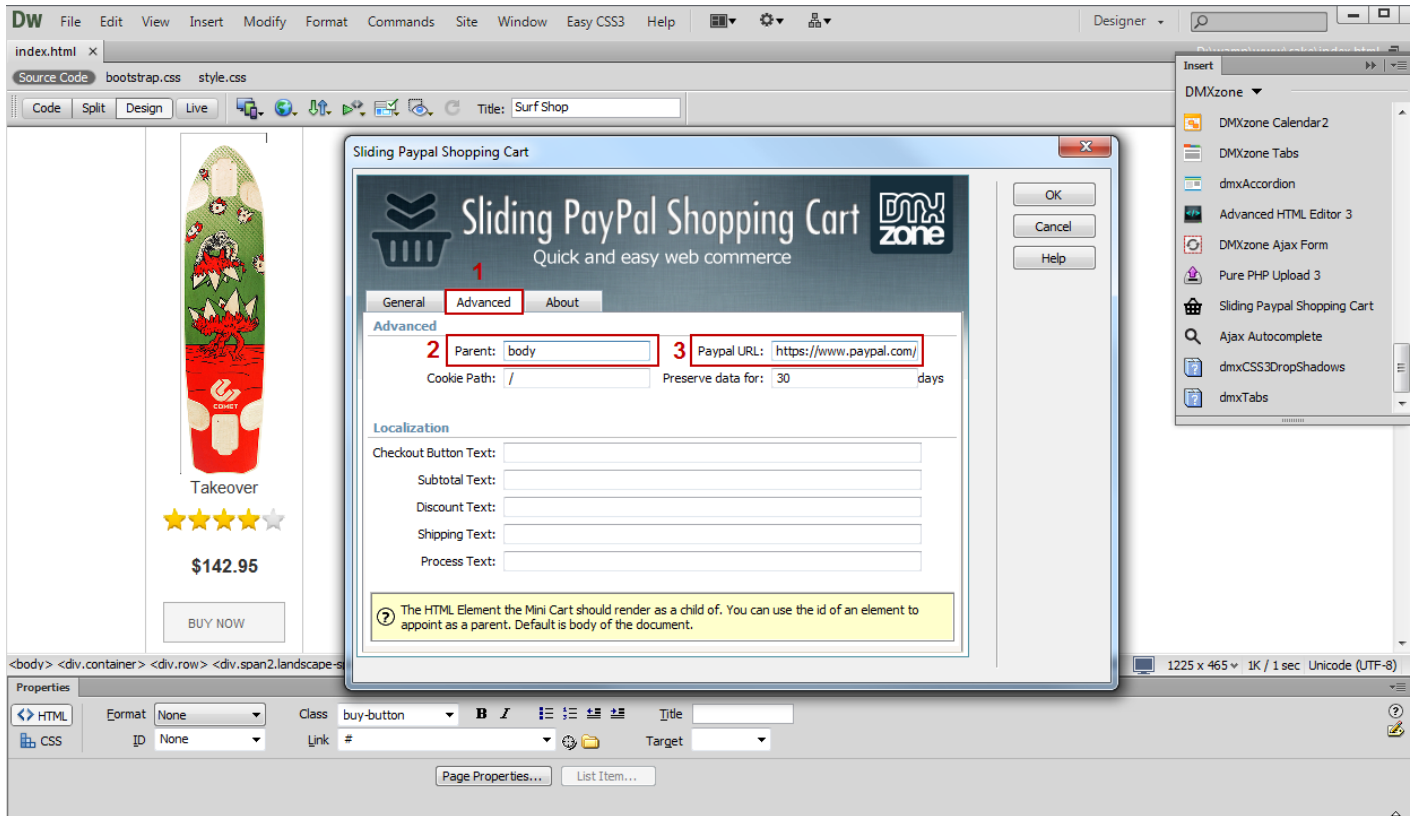
3. Choose one of the predefined **designs**, for our showcase we'll use the **light-blue** one.



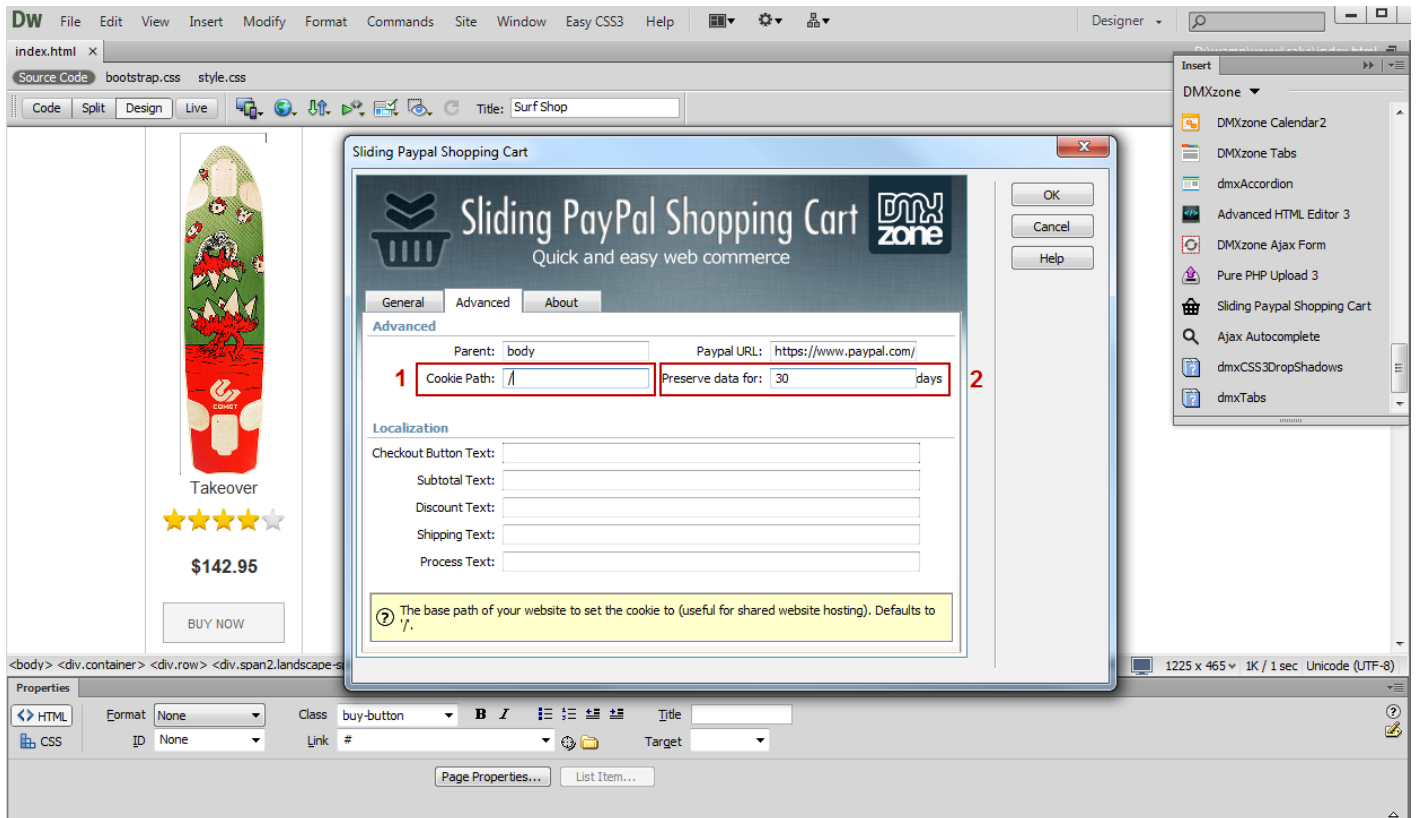
- You can use **Success URL** in order to redirect the users when the payment is completed. You can also use **Cancel URL** in order to redirect the users if they cancel the checkout before the payment is completed. Leaving these fields empty, both URLs will redirect the users to default PayPal pages.



- In the **advanced tab (1)**, you can **use the ID of any HTML element (2)**. The default parent element is the page body, which works fine in most of the cases. Additionally, you can **change the PayPal URL** if you are using sandbox or another version of the PayPal website **(3)**.



- Select the base path **(1)** of your website to set the cookie to. The default value is "/". Add the **number of days** that the users' browsers keep the cart data **(2)**.



7. Enter the checkout button, subtotal, discount, shipping and process texts to be used in the cart.

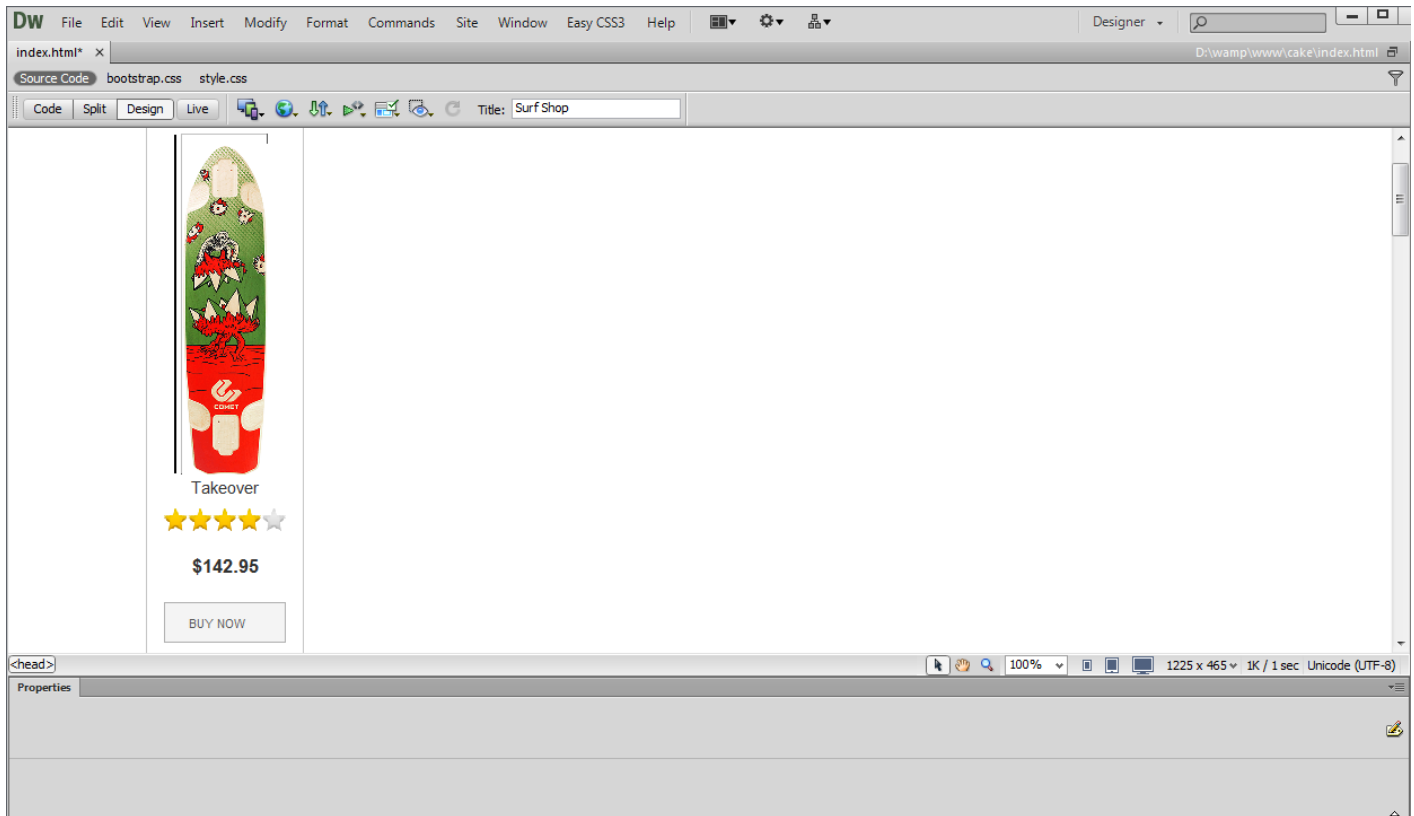

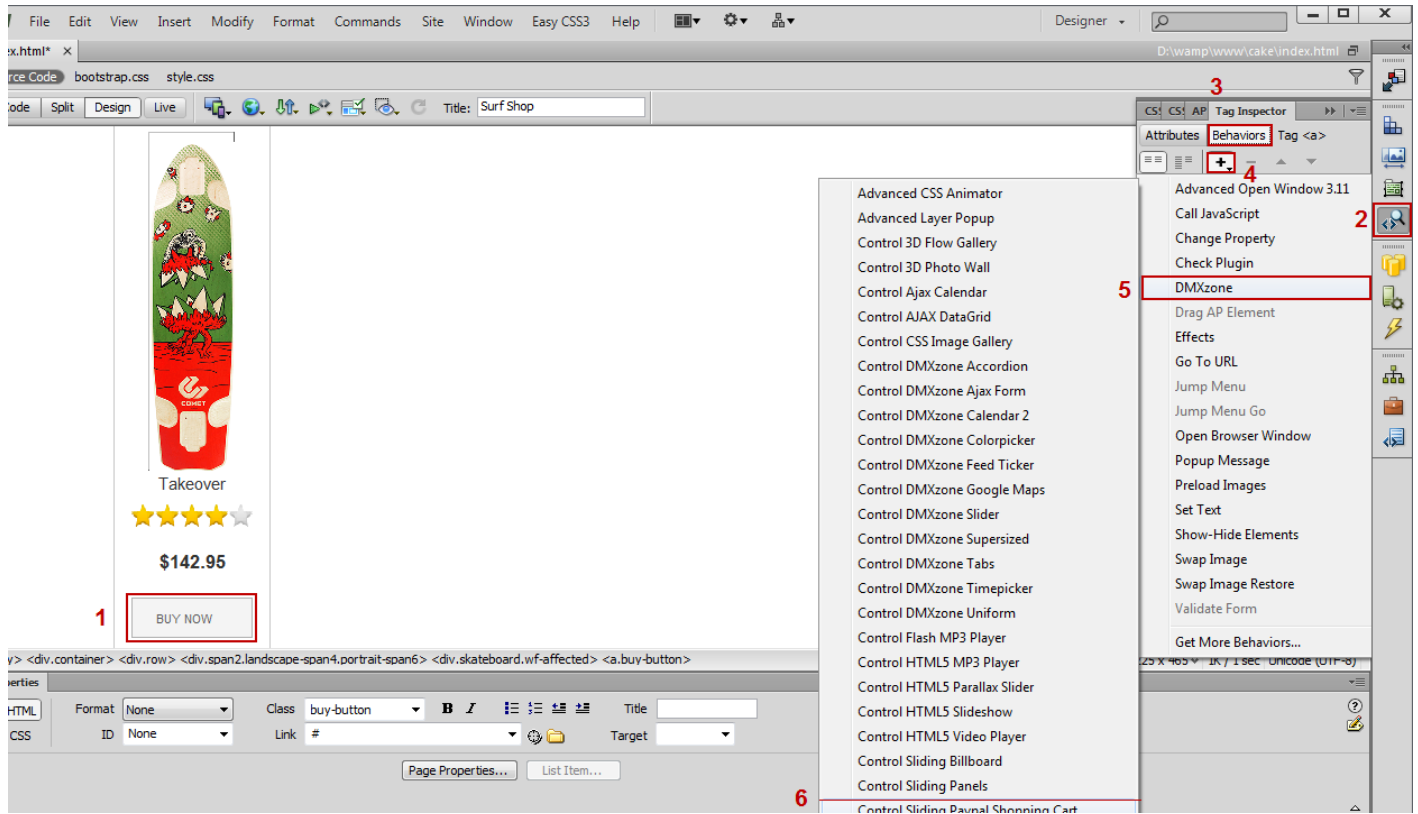

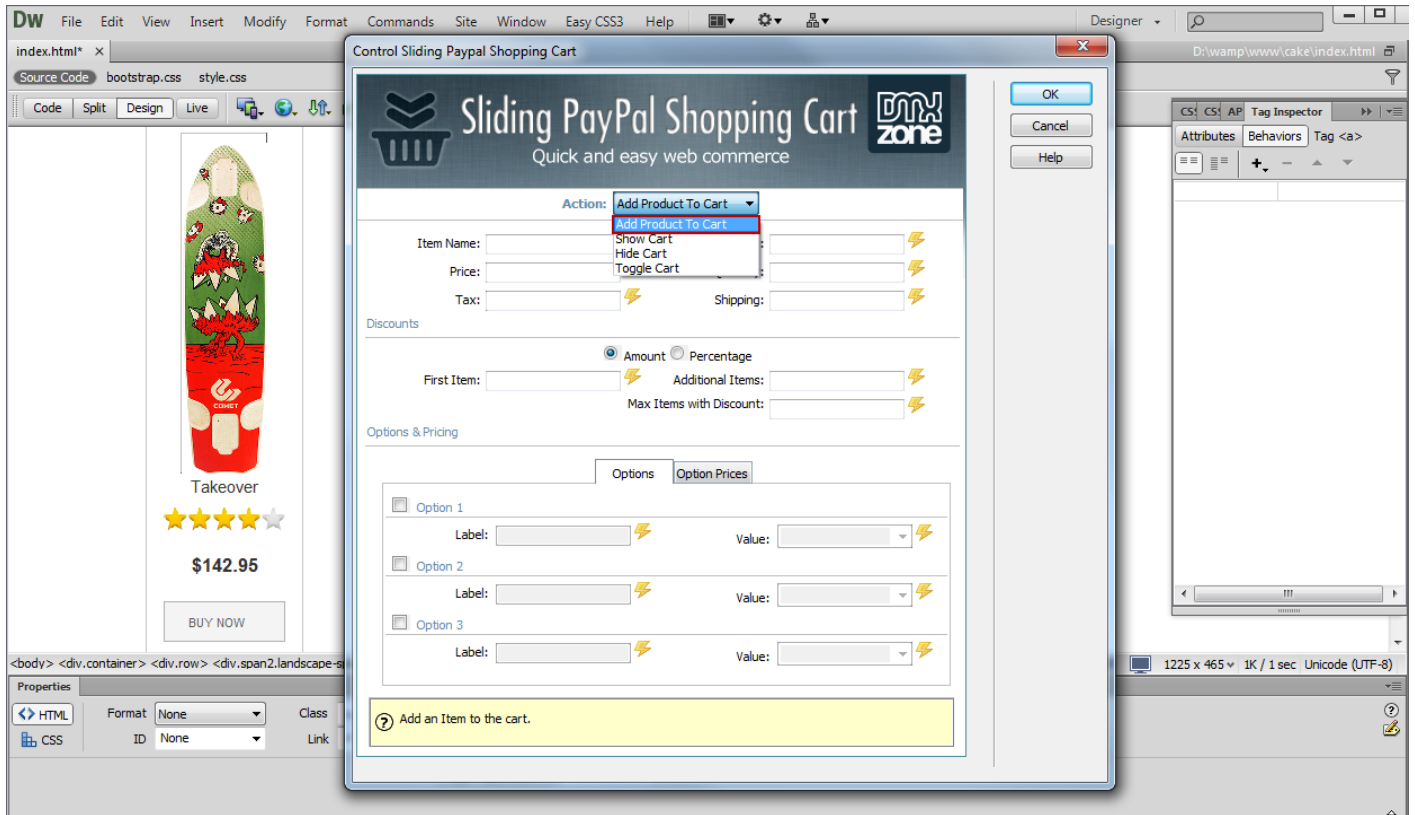
8. The Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart is added to our page. Now we are going to add the "Add to cart" functionality to our "Buy Now" button.



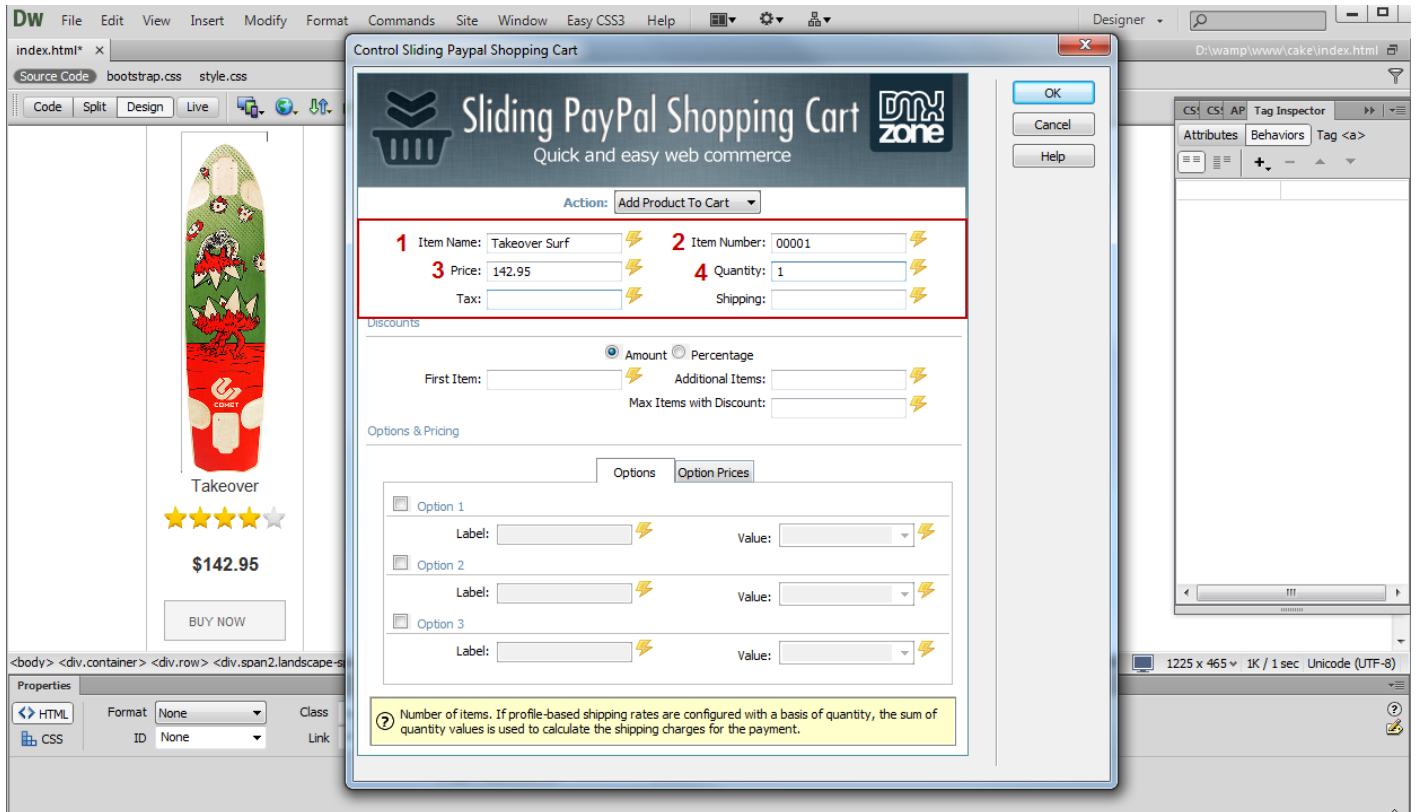
9. Select the **button (1)** and choose the **tag inspector (2)**. Click the **behaviors button (3)**, the **add behavior button (4)**, and select the **DMXzone menu item (5)**, where we choose the **control Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart menu item (6)**.



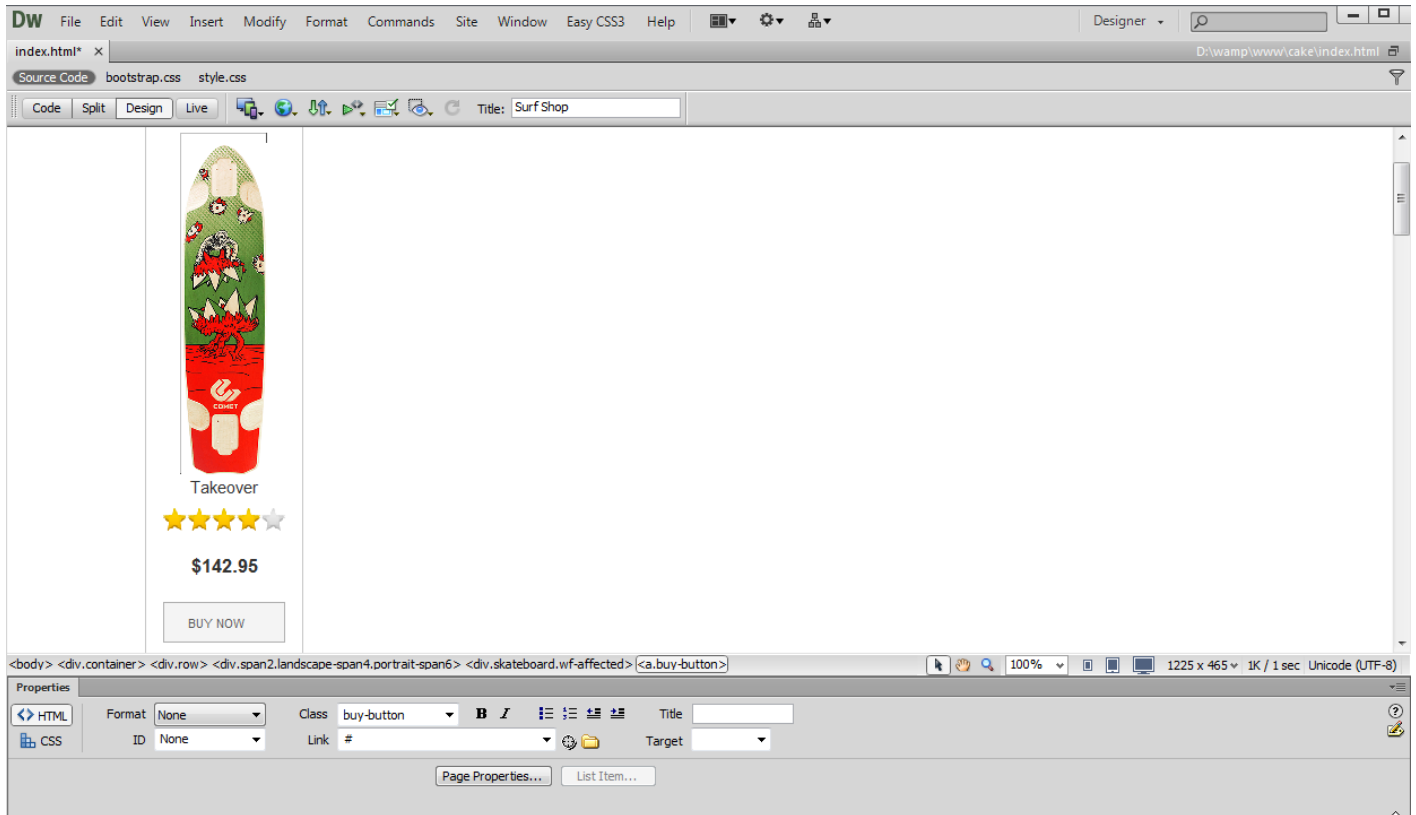
10. In the control Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart window, we will select **add to product cart action**.



11. Add the **name of your item (1)** that will appear in the shopping cart once it's added; give a unique **item number (2)** that you can use to track your sales in PayPal. Enter the **price of the product (3)** and **set the number of items (4)** to be added to the cart when the button is clicked. We leave the tax and shipping fields empty as we don't want to charge for them, but you can always add a fixed tax and shipping cost.









12. Now you can save your work and preview the result in the browser.

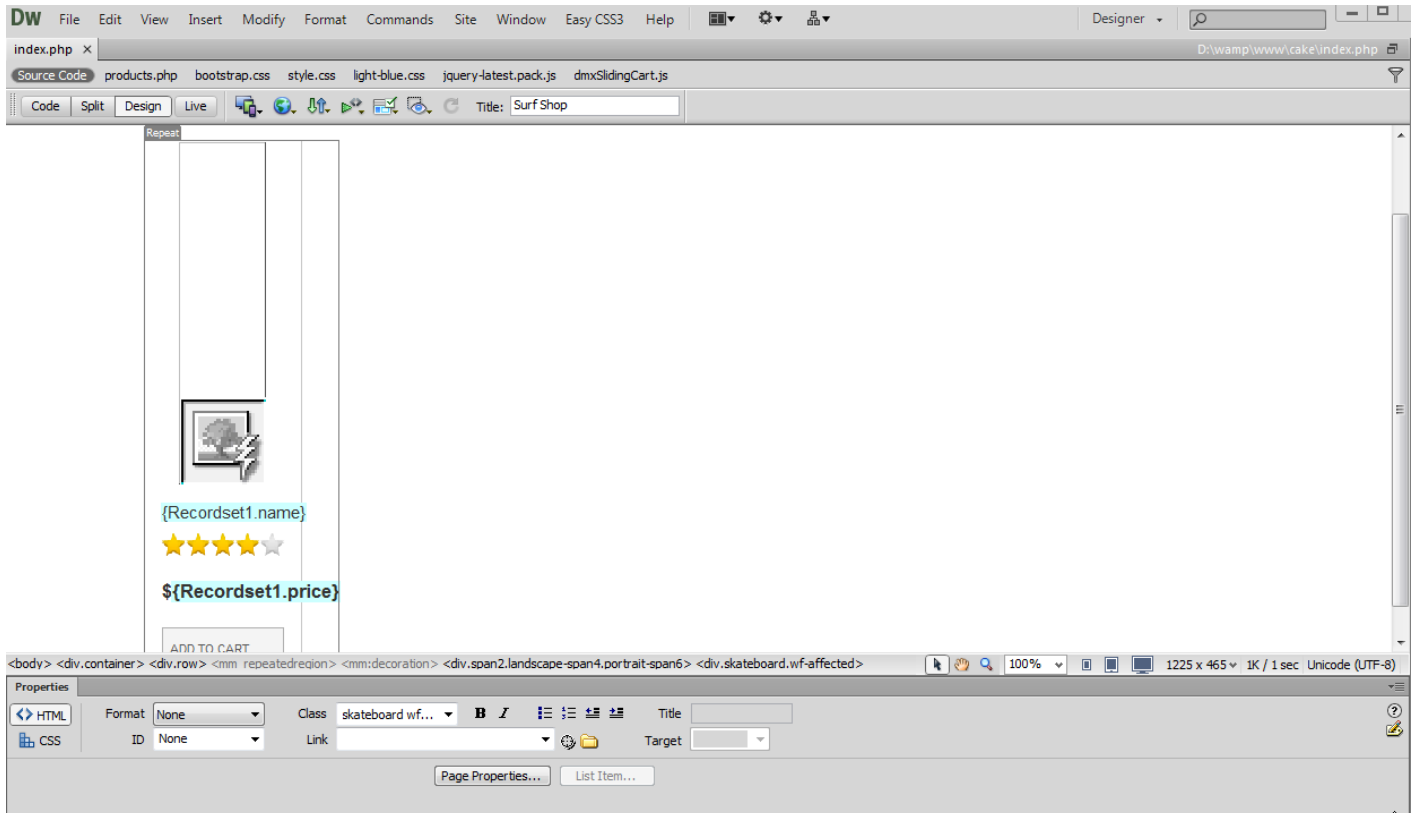

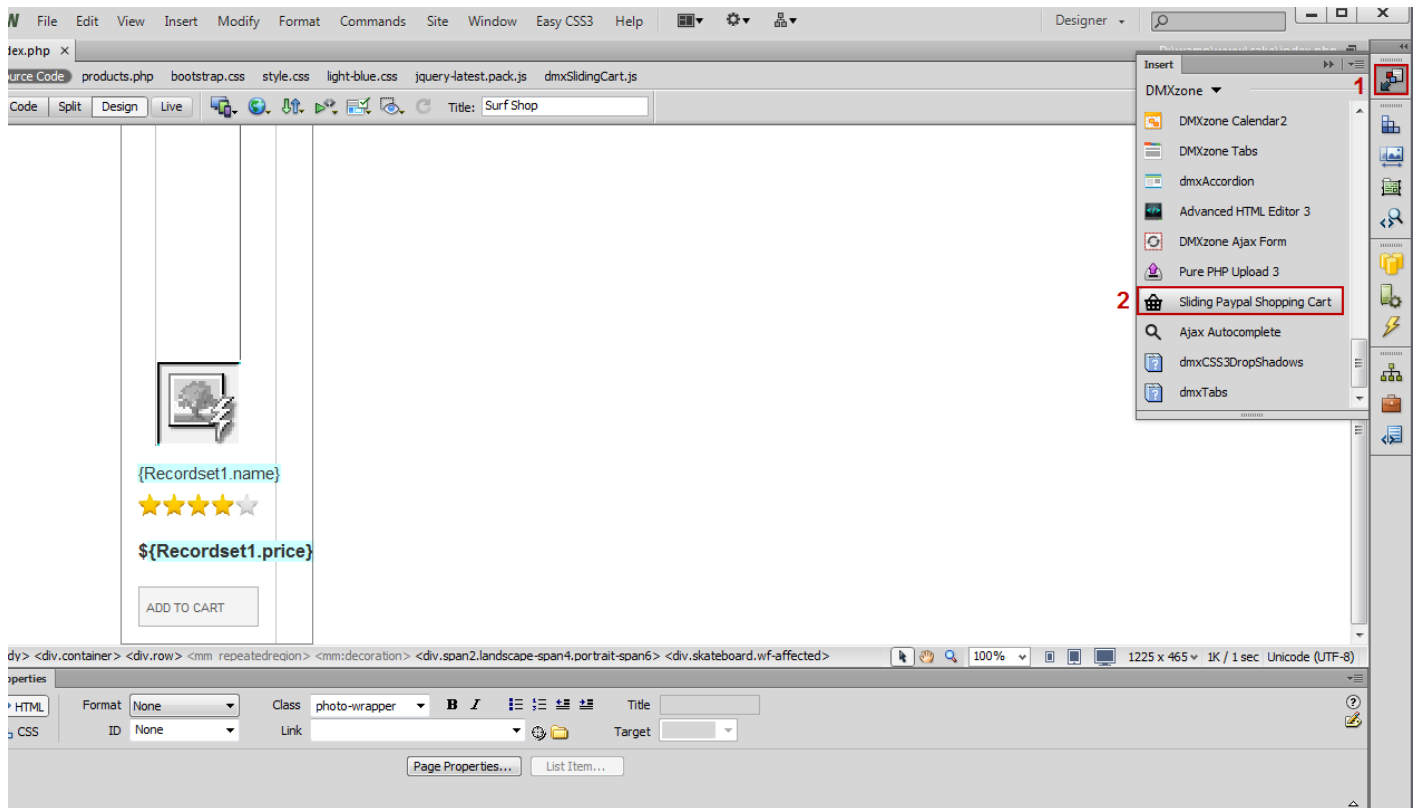

How to do it

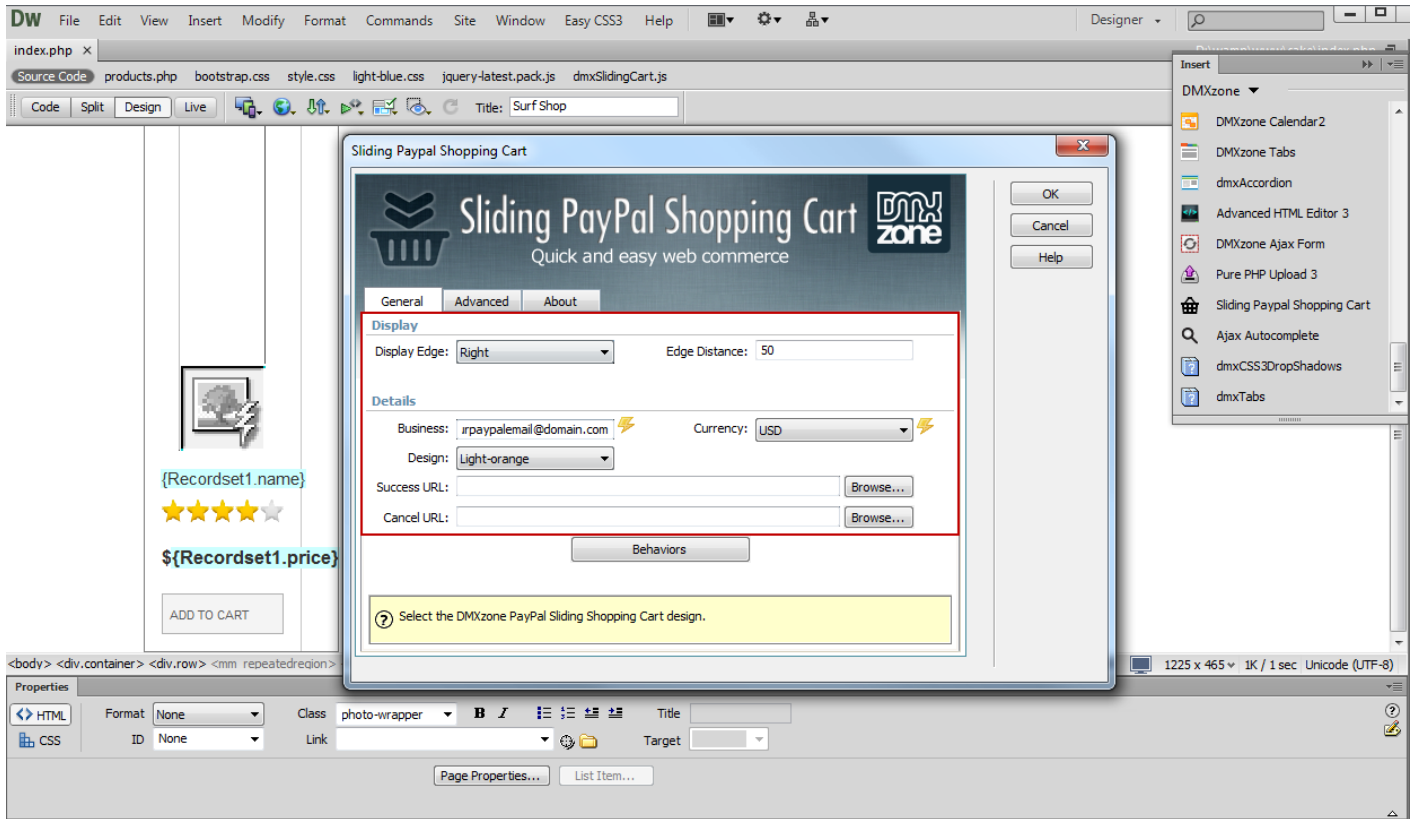
1. We created a dynamic page using a Standard Dreamweaver Recordset and a Repeat Region that shows the products on our page. We also added an "Add to Cart" button inside the repeat region.



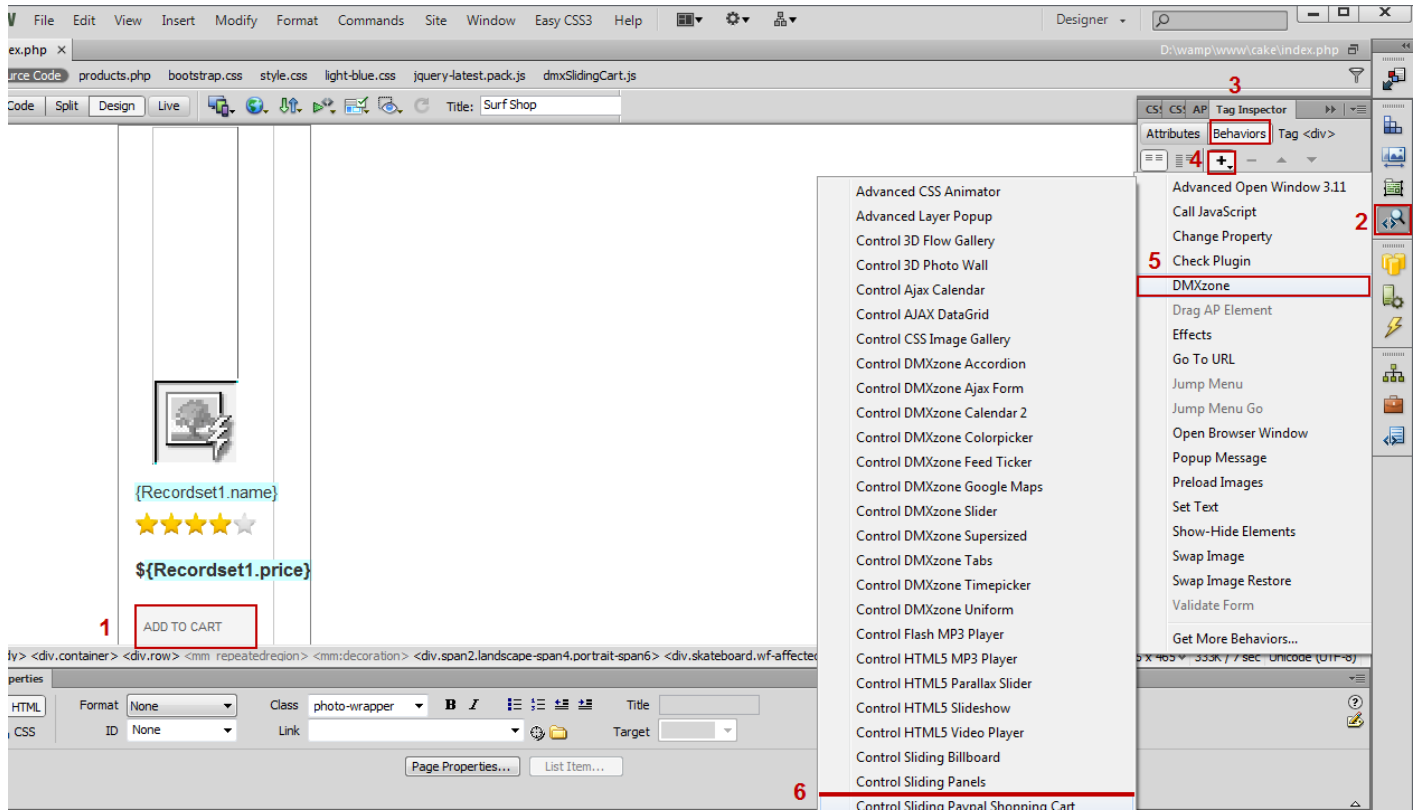
2. First we are going to add the Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart to our page. Click the **insert button (1)** and the **Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart icon (2)**.



- In the Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart window, we adjust the **general settings** of Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart.



- Select the “Add to Cart” button (1) and from the tag inspector button (2), click the Behaviors button (3). Click the add behavior button (4) and from the DMXzone menu item (5), choose the control Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart menu item (6).



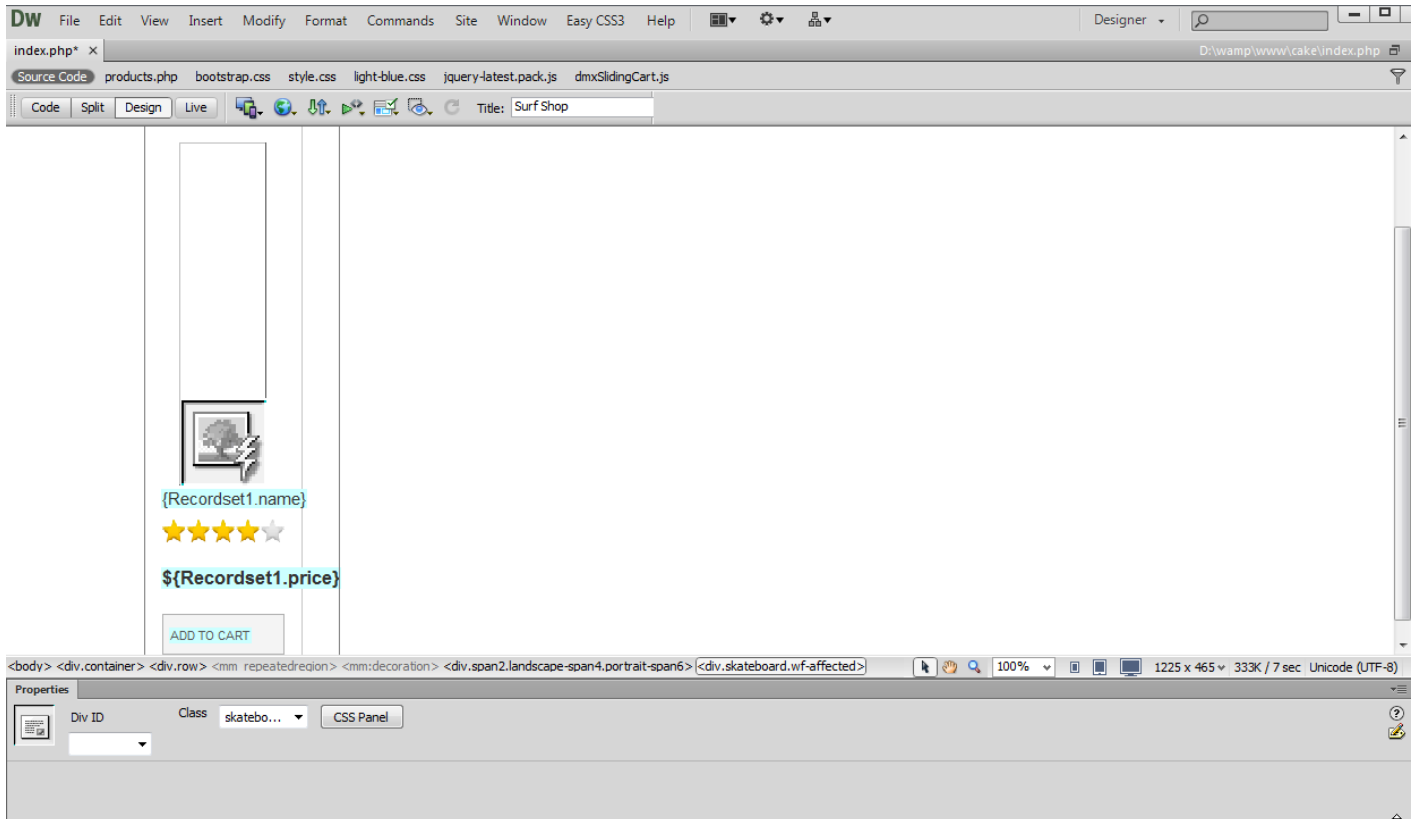

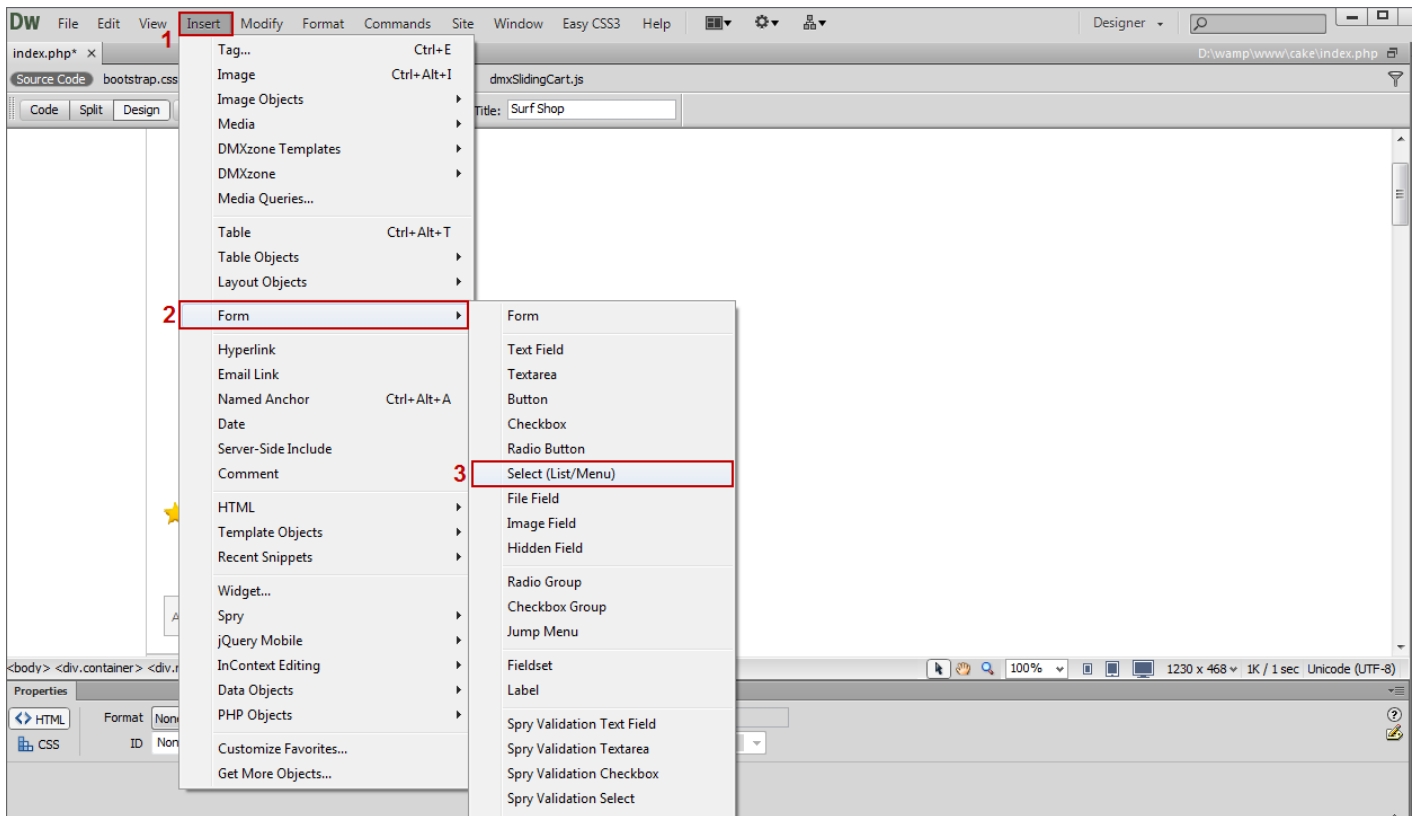

How to do it

1. We added Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart on our page. We have a product that we want to add several options to. Each of the options has a different price that will be added to the product price, if selected.

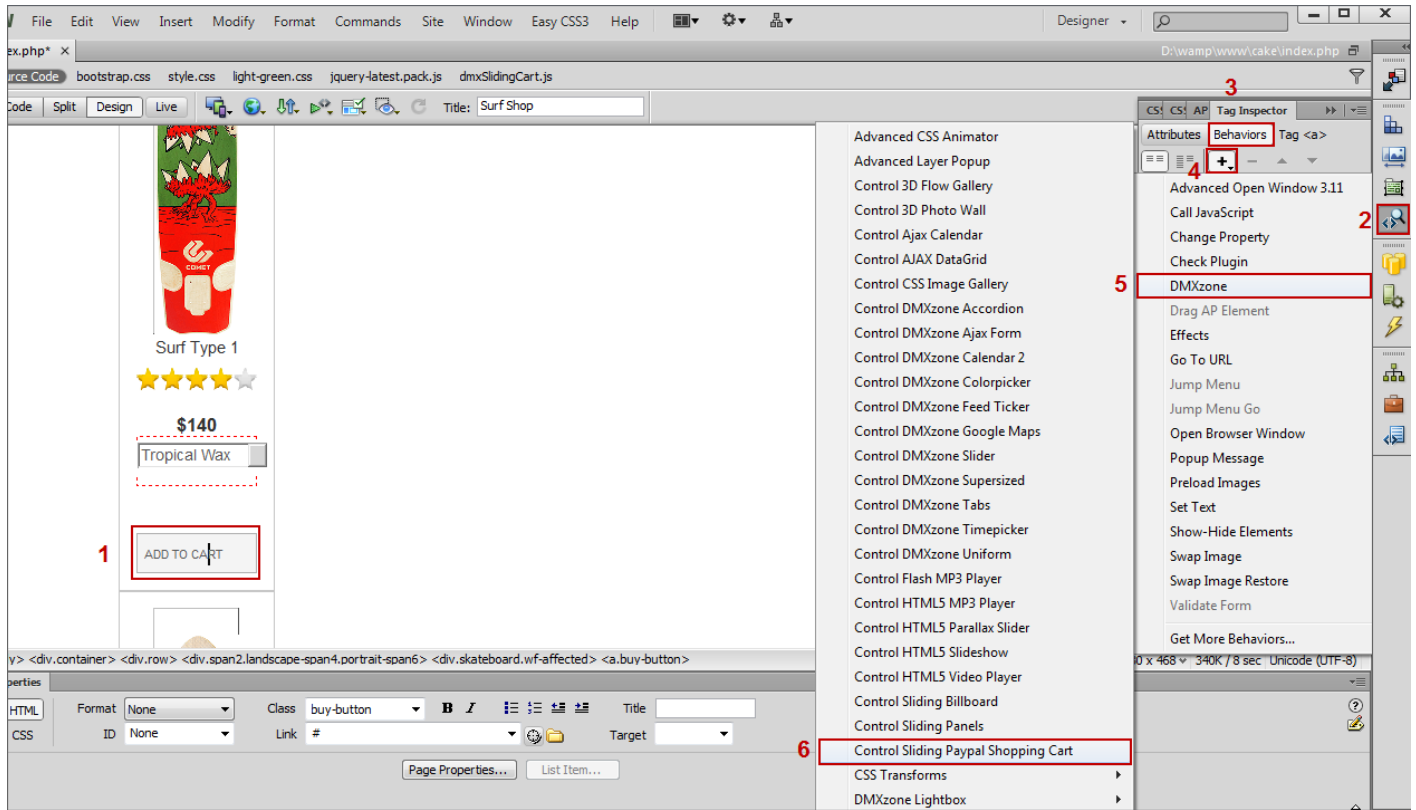
- Now we are going to add the options in the **select menu (1)**. Click the **list values button (2)** and **add the options** for the select menu **(3)** in the list values window.

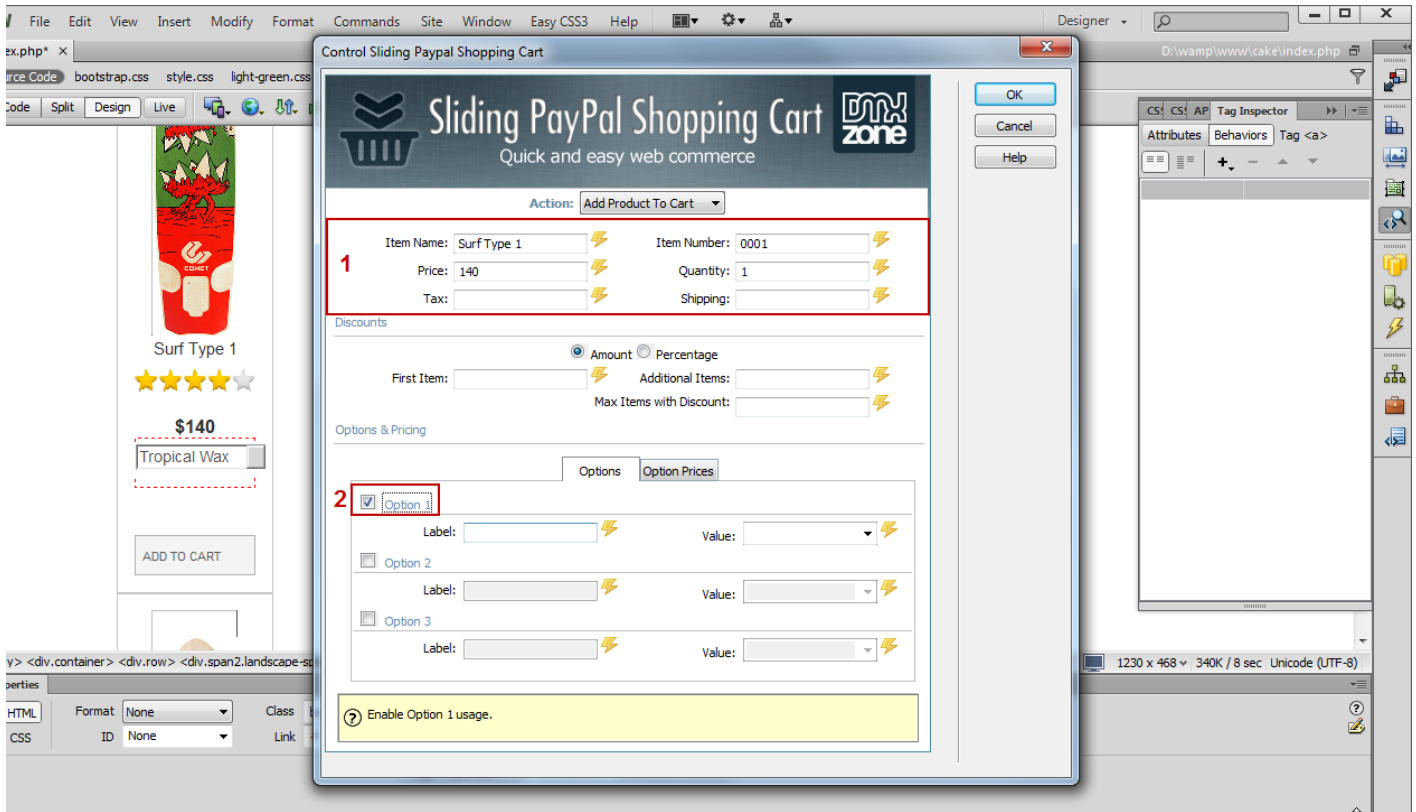

5. Select the “Add to cart” button (1) and from the tag inspector button (2), click the Behaviors button (3). Click the add behavior button (4) and from the DMXzone menu item (5), choose the control Sliding Paypal Shopping Cart menu item (6).



6. Add the **item info** in the control Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart window **(1)**. Note that you can have up to 3 different options with unlimited values for each of your products. Select **Option 1 checkbox (2)**, as we added only one Select Menu with options for our product.



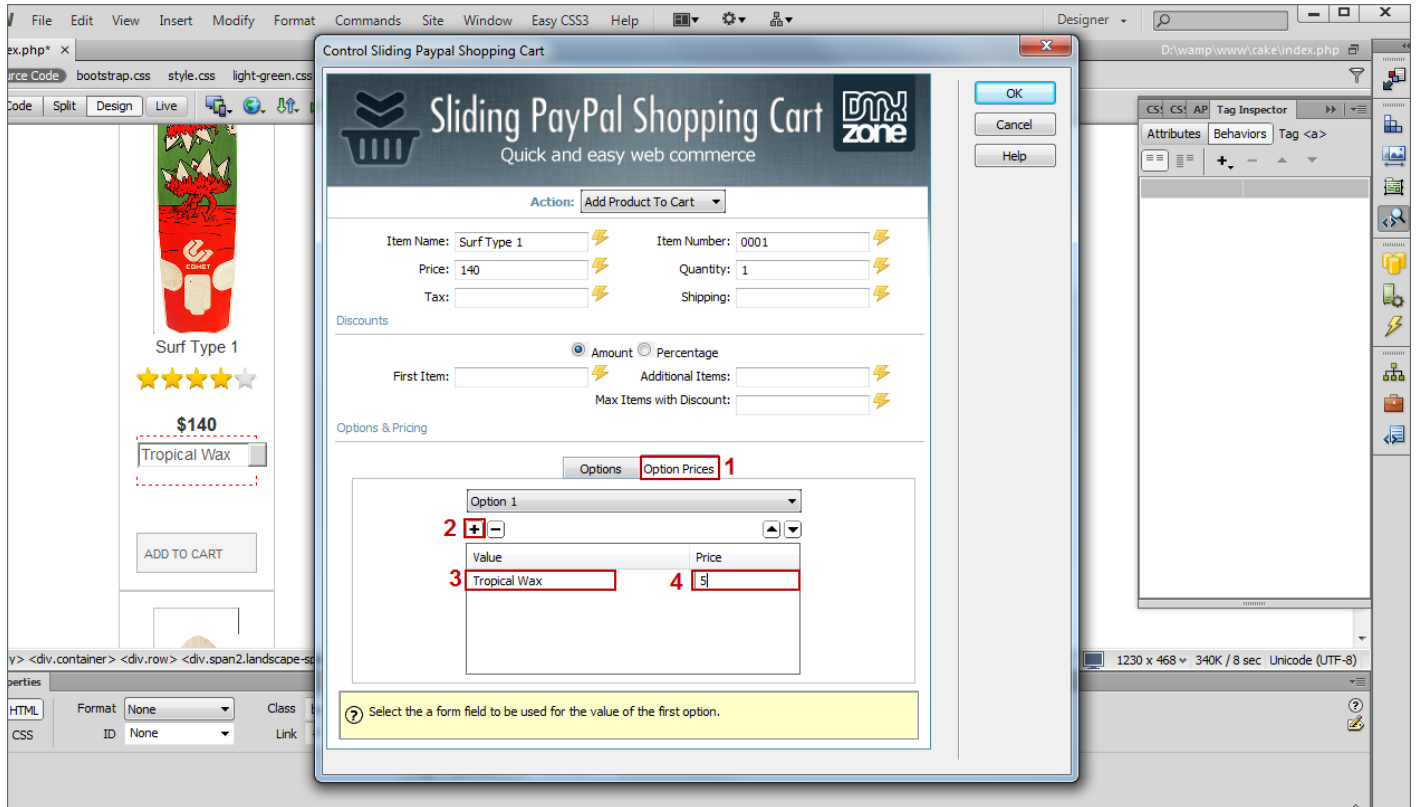
7. Add a **label for this option (1)** and in the value menu, **select the name of the select Menu** that we added on our page **(2)**.

9. We do the same for each option that we need to add price to.

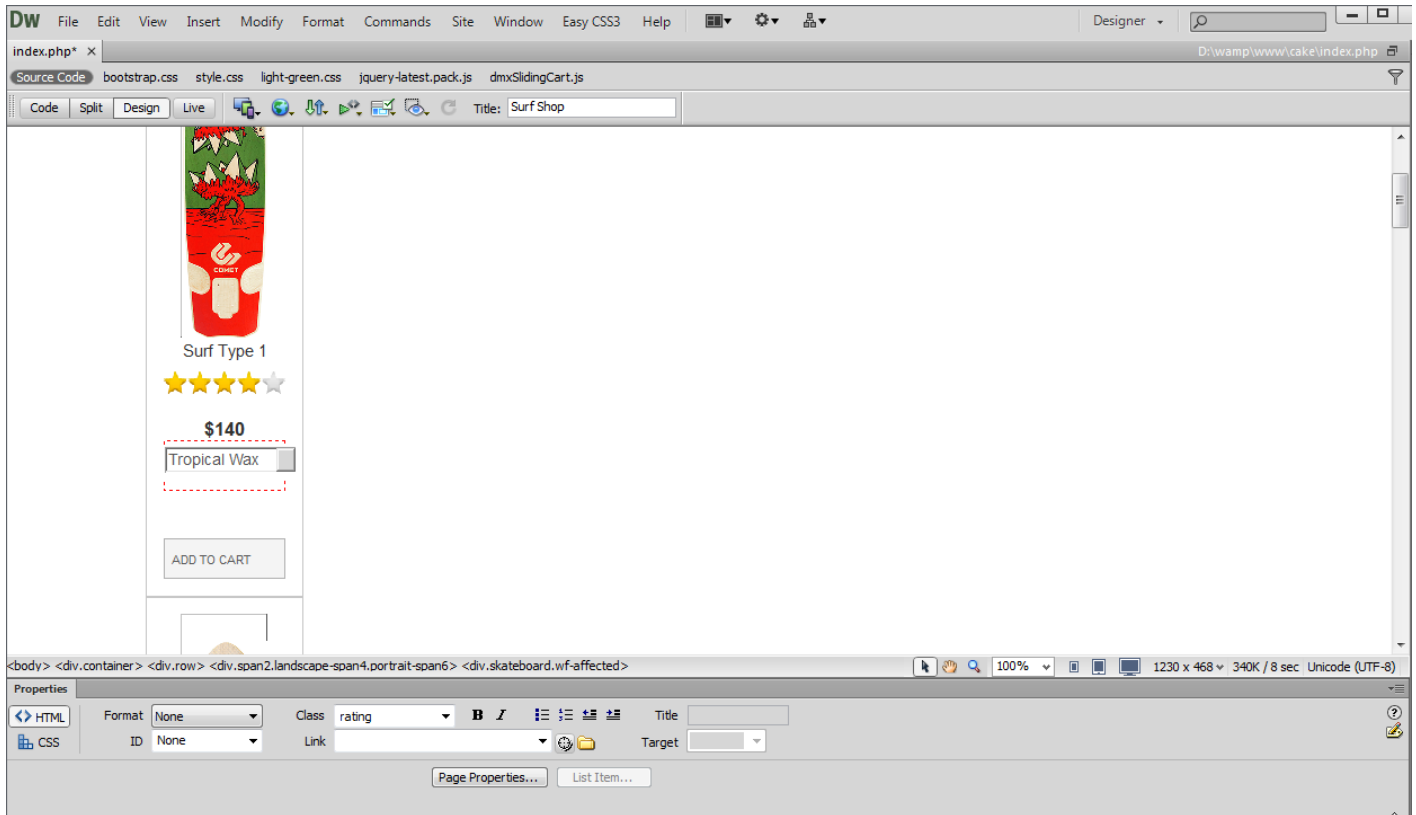

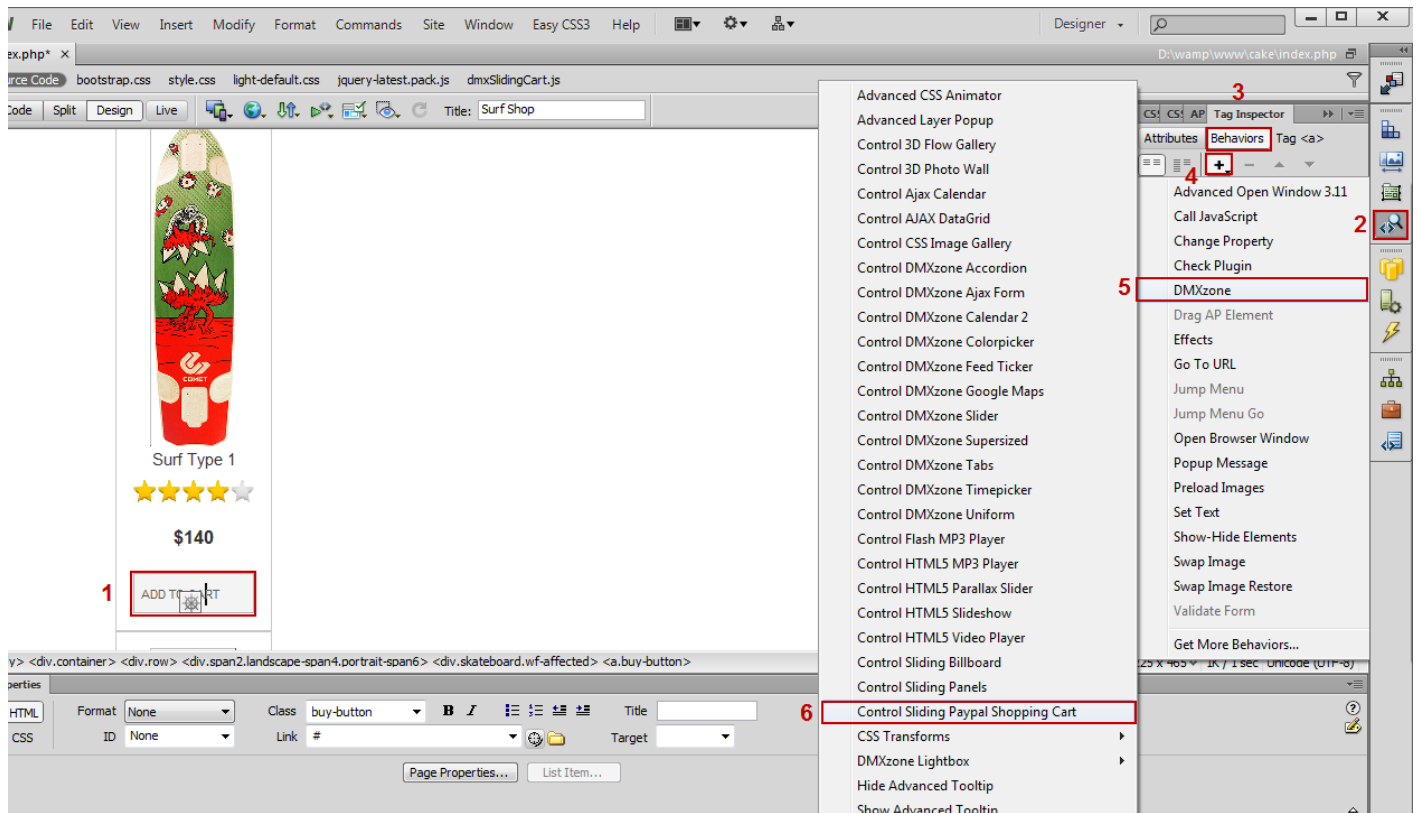

How to do it

1. We already added the Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart on our page. Now we are going to add the "Add to Cart" button and functionality to our products. Select the product purchase button (1) and from the **tag inspector button (2)**, click the **Behaviors button (3)**. Click the **add behavior button (4)** and from the **DMXzone menu item (5)**, choose the **control Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart menu item (6)**.



2. In the control Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart window, add the Item info.

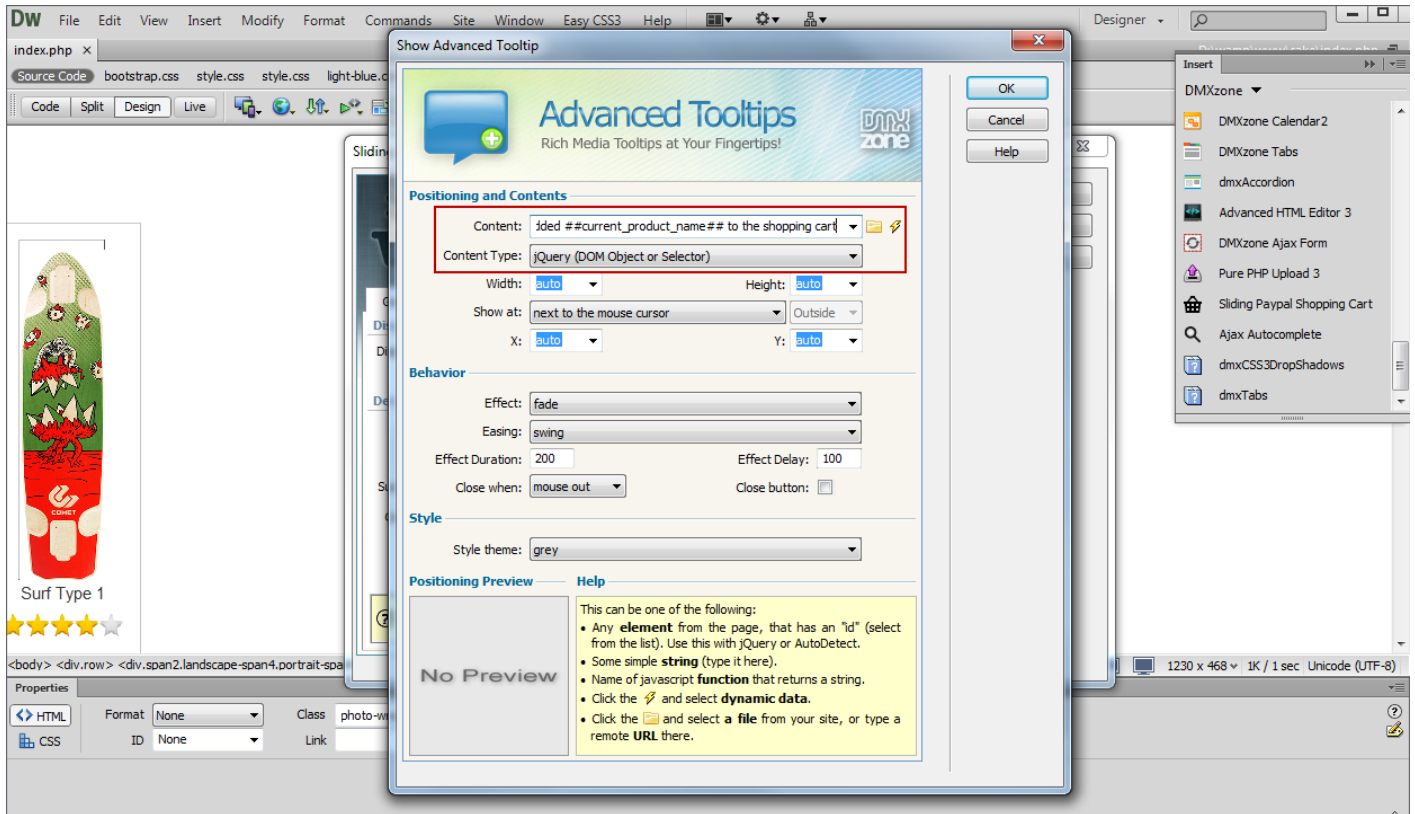
- In the behavior connector window, select **after a product is added to the cart (1)** and open the **DMXzone Folder (2)**.



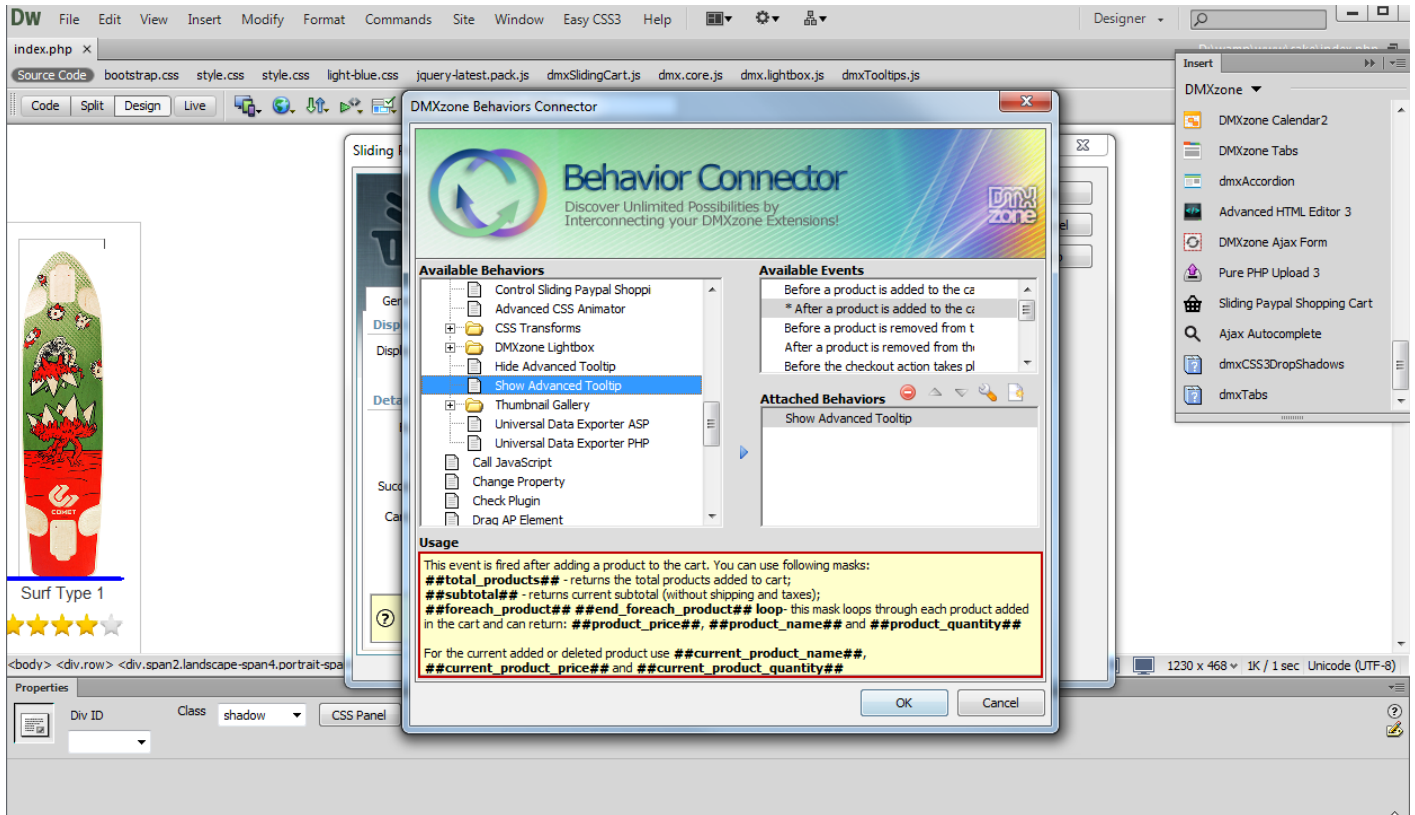
4. Select **show Advanced Tooltips (1)** and **add the selected behavior (2)**.

`##current_product_name##` - this mask returns the current product being added in or removed from the Sliding PayPal Shopping Cart. Our thank you message is: Thank you, you just added `##current_product_name##` to the shopping cart. The content type should be jQuery.



6. You can find the available masks in the yellow help area.




7. Click the OK button. Now you can save your work and preview the results in your browser.


